P.M. Abel company - patrol to Sengent checked back in o'k. patrol to woods at 13.6-92.5, got within a few yards of gun positions and observed two enemy as one lit a cigarette. Patrol then moved to left around n. edge of woods and heard quite a few enemy in nw. corner of woods 13.7-92.7.

Abel (200) patrol under Lt. Battis reached stream junction 13.7-93.8 received mg fire and they took cover and remained for 30 minutes. Heard voices at 13.5-93.9. Did not cross stream because of noise as they were 100 yards from mg, but tried to proceed up right of stream. Patrol progressed a few yards and withdrew. Group received mg fire from the same machine gun who ~~is~~ was on north side of north branch of stream -- approx. 13.7-93.9. They remained for a short period and obs. the light, presumably a light from a match to right flank on high ground. Motor cycle and truck were heard pulling out of Venargent. Went across bridge into woods at 15.0-94.6. and stopped. They heard a sound like a truck unloading empty shell casings. Motor-cycle and truck returned to Venargent. He assumes that bridge is in. Observed artillery flash from ey battery in low ground in the vicinity of 15.5-94.4. Patrol returned by same route.
