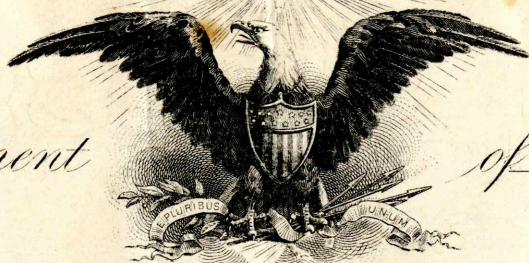


The COMMANDING OFFICER of the

Know Ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity, and abilities of Bernard A. Kellner

I do hereby appoint him Corporal in M. G. Co. of the First Regiment of Oklahoma
in the service ~~United States~~, to rank as such from the Sixth day of July one thousand nine hundred and Seventeen

He is therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of Corporal by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Non Commissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as Corporal. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time as he shall receive from me, or the future Commanding Officer of the Regiment, or other Superior Officers and Non Commissioned Officers set over him, according to the rules and discipline of War. This Warrant to continue in force during the pleasure of the Commanding Officer of the Regiment for the time being.
