- 2. General Davis received his first military training as an enlisted man and officer in the Illinois National Guard and commanded a machine gun company in combat during World War I. He was first commissioned in the Oklahoma National Guard in 1924 when he became Machine Gun and Howitzer Officer and assisted in the initial organization of the 45th Division. In 1928 he became Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, which position he held with distinction until 1937 when he became Chief of Staff. He discharged his duties in a superior manner during the prewar organization and training period and because of age-in-grade restrictions, was made Adjutant General of the State of Oklahoma in 1940.
- 3. As Adjutant General, General Davis directed the induction of the National Guard into Federal service in such an orderly manner that the State retained no liability whatever for Federal property or funds as an aftermath of 26 years of State service. He organized and operated as a section of his office the State Selective Service System throughout the war. Upon release of the National Guard from Federal service, General Davis initiated and brought to Federal recognition the new 45th Infantry Division and other units, with an ultimate strength nearly three times the former allotment of troops. His policies in this connection have been a model for other states and results have been outstanding. He performed his duties and discharged his responsibilities throughout his term of six years as Adjutant General without compensation, as an act of patriotic service to his State and Nation.
- 4. General Davis' distinguished record of service as a soldier in the service of his State and Country, in both peace and war, and his record of accomplishment as a patriotic citizen and a leader in the business and social life of Oklahoma, merits the highest commendation and is worthy of emulation by every member of the Oklahoma National Guard. As soldier and citizen, he displayed exceptional ability and by his able leadership, sound judgment, and untiring devotion to duty, made a lasting contribution of the highest order to the traditions, discipline, and esprit of the Oklahoma National Guard.

- 2. General McLain first enlisted in the Oklahoma National Guard in 1912 and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant of Infantry in 1914. He was in Federal service on the Mexican Border in 1916-17 and served as a Captain overseas during World War I. Following World War I, General McLain was reappointed a Captain of Infantry, Oklahoma National Guard, in 1921; promoted to Major in 1922; to Lieutenant Colonel in 1924; and to Colonel in 1925, when he became Chief of Staff of the 45th Division. He served as Chief of Staff during the formative period of the Division until 1937, when he was promoted to Brigadier General and assigned to command the 70th Field Artillery Brigade.
- 3. General McLain was inducted into Federal service with the 45th Division as a Brigadier General in September 1940. He went overseas with the Division in June 1943 and commanded the Division Artillery in combat until the Spring of 1944, when he was transferred to England and given another command. He later commanded the 90th Infantry Division and the XIX Corps in combat, and was promoted to Major General and Lieutenant General in the Army of the United States. In June 1946, General McLain accepted a commission in the Regular Army, with the permanent grade of Brigadier General.
- 4. At the request of the Governor, General McLain was assigned by the War Department to direct the organization of the new 45th Infantry Division, and brought the first units to Federal recognition early in September, 1946. When he was relieved from this assignment the latter part of October, more than two-thirds of the units of the Division had been inspected and recommended for Federal recognition, and all other units had been allotted and were in process of organization.
- 5. General McLain has rendered outstanding service as a soldier and citizen, in both peace and war, and his record is without parallel in the history of American arms.
