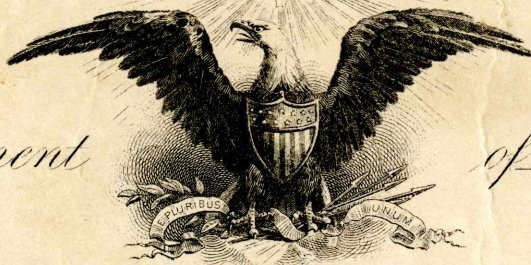


The COMMANDING OFFICER of the

To all who shall see these presents, greeting:

Know Ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity, and abilities of Roger G. Maus.

I do hereby appoint him Regimental Supply Sergeant of the First Regiment of Oklahoma Infantry in the service United States, to rank as such from the thirtieth day of July one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.

He is therefore, carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of Reg. Sup. Sergeant by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Non Commissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as Reg. Sup. Sergeant. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time, as he shall receive from me, or the future Commanding Officer of the Regiment, or other Superior Officers and Non Commissioned Officers set over him, according to the rules and discipline of War. This Warrant to continue in force during the pleasure of the Commanding Officer of the Regiment for the time being.

Given under my hand at the Head Quarters of the Regiment, at San Benito, Texas. this thirtieth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
