tinued here in an effort to reach a new waterfront working agreement but no progress was reported.

**WASHINGON,** Oct. 6.—An association that went coast shipowners are not willing to deal fairly with seafarers and want unenforced port labor laws before the federal maritime commission today by Harry Lundberg, head of the San Joaquin Union of Pacific, who said he hoped the commissioners would want you to put the heat on these dockers.

Chairman Wiles of the commission and negotiations for settlement of the maritime dispute are lagging because of Lundberg's absence from the coast, but the SHIP head said any delay could be attributed to the owner.

Lundberg said the seamen took the initiative before the commissioners took action and were going to shipowners in substance what was being passed on to the seamen in the form of their working conditions and other port policies.

We believe the government, if it wishes, has enough power to make the owners deal with us," Lundberg said. He added, however, that the men were opposed to arbitration of fundamental questions of union representation and the right of seafarers to determine their pay.

"Every WPA worker is better off than our cooks and stewards," he said.

"They work 20 hours a week and get \$65 a month, while cooks and stewards work 70 hours a week and get \$45 a month."

He said he was not certain if the 17,000 workers he represents would agree to an extension of the 15 day work week, but he said they had lined up with all this stalling. That is why I am here."

Lundberg planned to confer with 22 port labor leaders on the coast, boat inspection service, on a proposed 90 day postponement of the effective date of the Copeland safety at sea act which the public oppose on the grounds it infringes their rights.

**International Conclave**  
GENEVA, Oct. 7.—A conference of international maritime labor leaders opened yesterday with delegates seeking a worldwide agreement to improve sailors' working conditions.

To be sought for seamen were shorter hours, sickness insurance, paid vacations, and other working improvements.

A total of 88 delegates and 100 advisers, representing 28 nations which control 82 per cent of the world's merchant marine tonnage, attended the meeting. Germany and Italy were the only important maritime nations not represented.
