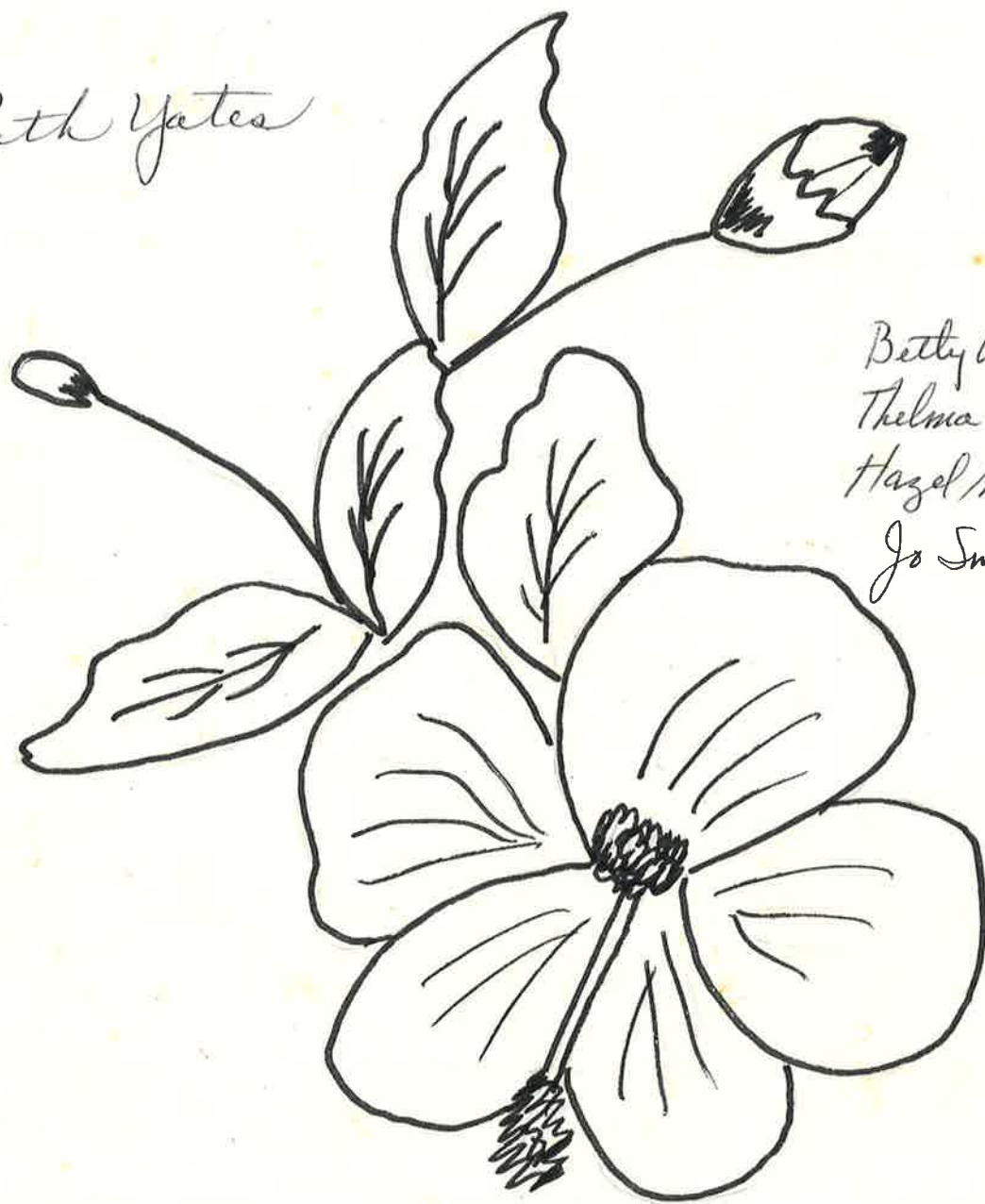

REGULAR MEETING OF THE UPPER KEYS GARDEN CLUB, DECEMBER 18, 1969

THIS MEETING WAS OUR CHRISTMAS PARTY AND OUR 30TH ANNIVERSARY.

THE OFFICERS WERE THE HOSTESSES AND BETTY WILSON SUPPLIED THE CHAMPAGNE. MR. WILSON EVEN SERVED IT AND DID A VERY GOOD JOB.

VIVIAN GROSS DID A FINE JOB OF INTRODUCING THE CHARTER MEMBERS AND JUNE THORPE PRESENTED HER WITH A LIVING EVERGREEN TREE "EVERGREEN FOR THE EVER FAITHFUL"

THE CHARTER MEMBERS PRESENT WERE: ~~MILLIE GASSER~~, JANET SABIN, FLORENCE *Booth*
VIVIAN GROSS, ~~BESSIE PRINE~~ *Violet Carpenter*

AND NOW SOME HISTORY OF OUR CLUB; IN 1963 WITH A MEMBERSHIP OF 43 THE MEMBERS DECIDED TO RAISE MONEY TO PURCHASE PROPERTY FOR THE FUTURE SITE. MRS. LEA SMITH GAVE THE FIRST DONATION OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS. MARGARET BOND BECAME INTERESTED AND SPOKE TO HER HUSBAND, DR. BOND, WHO GENEROUSLY GAVE THE PROPERTY THE GARDEN CLUB WAS BUILT ON. MONEY WAS RAISED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000.00 THAT YEAR AND WITH A MORTGAGE OF \$8,000.00 FROM THE BANK OF FLORIDA IN HOMESTEAD THE CLUB HOUSE WAS BUILT.

MR. GEORGE COFFIN, ARCHITECT, DREW THE PLANS AND TOOK CHARGE OVER THE BUILDING. MRS. TRACY AND HARRY HARRIS, COMMISSIONER, PLACED A CYLINGER WITH MEMBERS NAMES IN THE SOUTH SIDE FRONT WALL.

THE FIRST MEETING IN THE NEW BUILDING WAS HELD SEPTEMBER 15, 1964. THE OFFICIAL PUBLIC OPENING WAS HELD NOV. 29, 1964, OVER 200 FRIENDS CAME. MRS FRANK HEWETT, STATE PRESIDENT AND MRS. E. JORDON, DISTRICT DIRECTOR WERE AMONG THE GUESTS AT THE OPEN HOUSE.

THIS WAS A GREAT CHRISTMAS PARTY - TO HEAR FROM THE CHARTER MEMBERS HOW OUR CLUB WAS FOUNDED, MANY LOVELY PLANTS WERE EXCHANGED AND THE FOOD AND CHAMPAGNE ~~was~~ *was* DELICIOUS.

THIS BEING A "FUN" MEETING THERE WERE NO REPORTS READ.

THERE WERE 59 MEMBERS AND 2 GUESTS PRESENT.
