THE STANDARD SYSTEM SHALL BE USED. THERE WILL BE ONLY ONE FIRST (BLUE); ONE SECOND (RED); ONE THIRD (YELLOW); AND HONORABLE MENTION (WHITE), IF ENTRIES SO WARRANT.

TRI-COLOR (BLUE, RED AND YELLOW ROSETTE) IF MERITED; BEST BLUE IN CLASSES 1-3 AND 5A-6A. ALL FRESH MATERIAL

CREATIVITY AWARD (PURPLE ROSETTE) IF MERITED; TO BEST BLUE RIBBON IN CLASS 2-4 5B-6B.



ARTISTIC DIVISION RULES:

1. FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE USED NEED NOT BE GROWN BY EXHIBITOR.
2. ENTRIES MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR.
3. PLANT MATERIAL USED LISTED ON A 3" x 5" CARD.
4. ACCESSORIES IN CLASSES WHERE PERMITTED ARE OPTIONAL. BASES MAY BE USED IN ALL CLASSES.
5. ARRANGEMENTS ARE NOT TO EXCEED 20" WIDE 30" HIGH AND 15" DEEP.
6. BACKGROUNDS AND FASTENING MATERIAL MAY NOT BE VISIBLE ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF FURNISHED BACKGROUND.
7. WILTED FLOWERS IN AN ARRANGEMENT SHOULD BE REPLACED ON SATURDAY A.M. WITH MATERIAL AS NEAR AS POSSIBLE AS THE ORIGINAL.

CLASS II WINDSWEPT

DRY ARRANGEMENT WITH DRIFTWOOD OR SHELLS, OR CORAL ACCESSORIES PERMITTED.

CLASS III TROPICAL FOLIAGE

FRESH FOLIAGE - NO BLOOMS.

CLASS IV HEAVEN-MAN-EARTH

FRESH MATERIAL - ACCESSORIES PERMITTED.  
JAPANESE OR ORIENTAL.

CLASS V MINIATURES - NOT TO EXCEED 3" HIGH OR 3" WIDE.

A - FRESH MATERIAL  
B - DRY MATERIAL

CLASS VI SMALL ARRANGEMENTS - NOT TO EXCEED 5" WIDE, 8" HIGH

B - DRY MATERIAL

- CLASS 6 OTHER FRUIT

SECTION O - VEGETABLES

- CLASS 1 - TOMATOES - THREE PER PLATE
- CLASS 2 PATIO OR CHERRY TOMATOES - FIVE PER PLATE

HORTICULTURAL DIVISION RULES:

1. SPECIMENT PLANT CONTAINERS SHOULD BE COVERED WITH BROWN PAPER BAGS IF UNSIGHTLY (RUSTY CAN, MINERAL COATED CLAY POTS).
2. POTTED PLANTS MUST HAVE BEEN IN THE POSSESSION OF THE OWNER FOR NINETY DAYS OR MORE.
3. LEAVES MUST BE FREE OF RESIDUE, BUT NOT OILED. NO INSECT DAMAGED LEAVES.
4. ENTRY TAGS MUST SHOW BOTANICAL AND COMMON NAME OF ENTRY.
5. CONTAINERS WILL BE FURNISHED FOR CUT SPECIMENS.
6. AN EXHIBITOR MAY MAKE MORE THAN ONE ENTRY IN A CLASS PROVIDED EACH ENTRY IS A DIFFERENT VARIETY.
7. CUT FLOWER SPECIMENS MUST CONSIST OF THREE BLOOMS PER CONTAINER EXCEPT - ONE ROSE - ONE ORCHID - ONE ALOE - ONE GLADIOLUS, AND ONE HIBISCUS.
8. ROSES MUST BE SHOWN WITH FOLIAGE.

ONE IN HORTICULTURE AND ONE IN ARTISTIC FOR THE EXHIBITOR WINNING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF BLUE RIBBONS IN EACH DIVISION.

EDUCATIONAL AWARD (BROWN & WHITE ROSETTE) TO EDUCATIONAL AWARD, IF MERITED.

GENERAL RULES:

1. COMPETITION IS OPEN TO ALL GARDEN CLUB MEMBERS AS WELL AS AMATEUR GARDENERS AND ARRANGERS.
2. ONE ENTRY PER PERSON PER CLASS IS ALLOWED. AS MANY CLASSES AS DESIRED MAY BE ENTERED.
3. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 9:30 AM, MARCH 30TH, 1979.
4. POTTED PLANTS, DRY ARRANGEMENTS OR ANY OTHER WHICH WILL HAVE NO EFFECT FROM EARLY PLACEMENT SHOULD BE BROUGHT MARCH 29TH, 1979, BETWEEN 10:00 AM AND 4 PM.
5. UPPER KEYS GARDEN CLUB WILL NOT ASSUME LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR PERSONAL INJURY.
6. SIX ENTRIES IN EACH ARTISTIC CLASS.
7. EXHIBITS MAY NOT BE REMOVED BEFORE 4 PM MARCH 31ST, 1979.
8. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED BUT WILL BE MARKED "NOT IN COMPETITION".
9. NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS OR FOLIAGE MAY BE USED. CONTRIVED, TREATED OR SPRAYED MATERIAL MAY BE USED IN CLASSES SO STATING.
10. PLANTS ON CONSERVATION LIST OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA MAY BE USED IN ARRANGEMENTS IF GROWN BY EXHIBITOR OR LEGALLY ACQUIRED.
11. ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.
12. ONLY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING AFTER 10:00 AM UNTIL JUDGING IS COMPLETED.
