Spain controlled the Halifax, but we owe our most intimate account of the area during the seventeenth century to a ship-wrecked Quaker, Jonathan Dickinson.

September, 1696, had much in common with other Septembers in Florida. It was hurricane season then, as now, and the barkentine Resolution, bound from Jamaica to Philadelphia, was tossed ashore near Jupiter Inlet.

Aboard the ill-fated ship was the Quaker Jonathan Dickinson, his wife, his child, and a number of other persons, both free and slave. The painful journey of this party northward along the coast to St. Augustine, and eventually to Charleston, was duly recorded and published under the title God's Protecting Providence. In this quaint book we find the most intimate account of the Halifax region in the late seventeenth century.

Leaving the Indian village of Jobe (which Dickinson rendered as Hoe-Bay) at Jupiter Inlet, the party traveled northward to the village of Jeece (Ais) on the Indian River. Here they tarried while one of the party, Solomon Cresson, went ahead with ~~an~~ several Indians ~~indians~~ to reach the Spaniards in St. Augustine. Cresson was spared part of his journey, however, for somewhere along the Halifax, north of the Inlet, he encountered a ~~southward~~ ~~bound~~ ~~piragua~~ under Captain Sebastian Lopez.

Lopez was heading south under instructions to bring the shipwrecked Englishmen to St. Augustine. Word, spreading from village to village, had reached the Spanish governor ~~for~~ ~~the~~ ~~fact~~ ~~of~~ these unfortunate mariners -- who were at the same time interlopers. ~~xx~~
