Again in 1954-55, she was a Room Mother and Health Chairman and continued with the responsibilities that accompany these positions. During this year, tests were given for Diabetes; also the first year for the Massachusetts Vision Test. Salk Vaccine was another project for this year and all records and consent slips were handled by "K".

During the following school year, 1955-56, "K" was still Health Chairman and continued with the good work. It was this year that the TB Mobile Unit for school and community was brought to the Keys. It was through "K" endless efforts that this was brought about. This school year she was of invaluable assistance to the Health Coordinator in securing the films on "Human Relations". Several Cancer films were secured and shown in the school and community. It was this year also that the Seniors, upon graduation, received a copy of their complete immunizations all through school. Miss "K" had this responsibility and did a very good job. In 1956-57, "K" was appointed as Secretary of the school and her responsibilities and duties have been numerous and of utmost importance. Yet "K" still took time out to take part in the Health program and wrote and directed the play that was presented to the P.T.A. by the Health Council that year. She was also a Room Mother again that year.

And now in the present school year, 1957-58, we find her still at her job as secretary of the school, Publications Chairman, Assistant Health Coordinator and County Council Publicity Chairman, Room Mother and sometimes acts as a mother to the 'little tots' that come to her with tears in their eyes and problems in their hearts.
