Havana, September 12 1764

Having arrived to the St Augustin Port of Florida the 7th of May of this year and ~~Research~~ ~~research~~ in Pursuit of the Haveray Colonel Don Francisco Osete, the Governor, and Captain Grant [?] came with the District of my Commission. Today without any doubt I admit to her, and after evincing this Disguise, continue with the question, that I was appeared with caution, that if my return to it, was done ~~was~~ ~~most~~ inside (within) the Florida keys.

Answering without Delay, ~~that~~ ^{that} I know such keys, ~~see~~ never heard or mention of them, and less mention that they existed, since being a native from that country, it's impossible ~~to~~ ^{to} have knowledge of them. (evidently) undoubtedly, that this keys they were found and located in between this Island, and the South Point of Florida ~~east~~ east, and west of the ~~above~~ Bahama Channel

Replying that the mentioned keys were called the Lappities and the Havana Hill (or Mountain), ownership of the Captain General, always at his command, because of them my ship was forced ^{by} going by I found 14 Banks of ^{reefs} ~~reefs~~ ~~reefs~~ that were loaded with wood and ~~reefs~~.

All of the scores he got up from the clear kind of coast and he ~~to~~ ~~the~~ ~~that~~ confirmed the same (testified), adding one question, that the provisions were plenty and that in Bats he was awaiting for a message from Catalonia, so ~~that~~ he can ~~know~~ learn and finish them since the mentioned keys belong to the Territory

of EAST Florida. in which He is Captain
GPAI and THAT Nobody within His Permission
could cut wood, ~~and~~ or fish in there.

gives details as to size of his garrison and where stationed: Apalache, Rio de San Marcos, Apaichicoli, Gualé, Isla Santa Catalina (frontier against the English settlements), Timuqua, Escalamoto, Matanzas, San Juan, San Agustín. Has been expecting enemy all spring. From Havana he's warned that enemy designs to assemble at Cayo de Guesas (Key West) to invade and sack the place. It would be a good thing to eliminate the English from San Jorge. From there entrance into the colony is easy. Would like the Armada de Barlomento to come with 300 men to demolish the English fort; site could then be resettled with Canary Islanders, etc.

Seen in Council Jan 29, 1682.
Among enclosures are depositions as to enemy's plans made by a native of Ostend and a native of Norfolk.

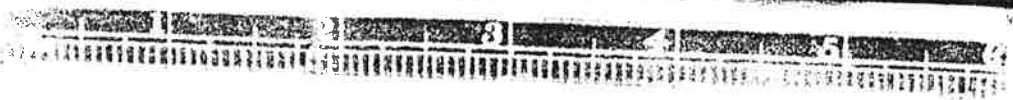
