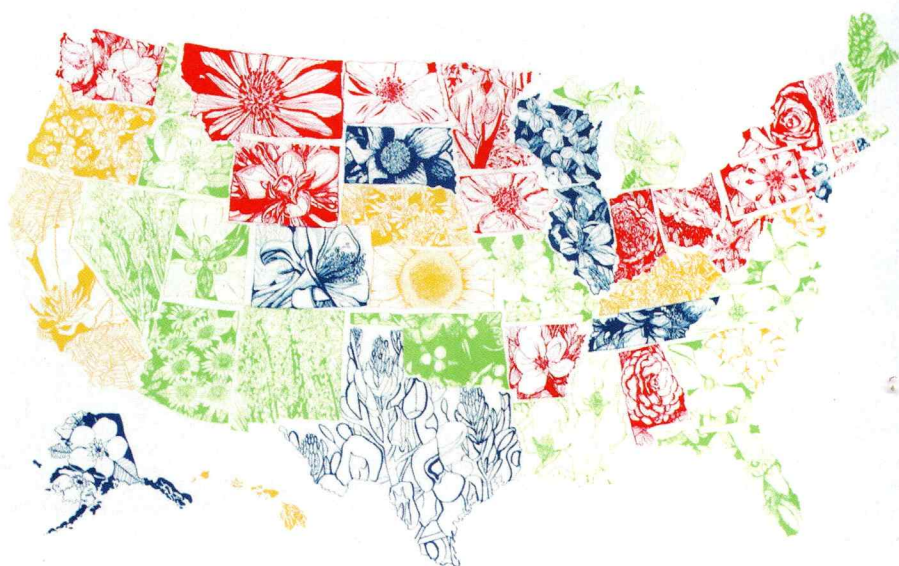

A small pouch of wildflower seeds is included with each print. National Garden Clubs has been fortunate to partner with Kristen, making these one-of-a-kind prints available through Member Services. Each print is \$25, with an additional \$6 for shipping. Any multiples of the small prints are \$10 for shipping. The print of the 50 states is \$55, plus \$7 shipping. 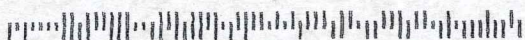
