CIRCULATION

MEMBERSHIP LISTS: (It is vitally important the Florida Gardener be given this information)

1. Name of club or circle (If applicable).

2. The identifying FLORIDA GARDENER code number. Each club/circle is assigned one.

3. The organization's location - city or town.

4. Full mailing address, including ZIP CODE, of each eligible member.

When preparing the list it would help if: The members are listed alphabetically, double spaced between subscriptions, print or type the list, note FFGC Life Members and their assigned numbers, include 25¢ for each change.

Incidentally, the first three items should appear on all membership lists, changes of address, correspondence in general or any point in question, requiring Gardener action.

In preparing the club's membership list for GARDENER mailing, please use the <u>SAME</u> name as previously entered on the FLORIDA GARDENER mailing files. Example: If the subscription label reads "Mrs. J. A. Doe", your listing should read "Mrs. J.A. Doe" - not Mrs. John A. Doe, etc. -- Gardener files cannot be certain these names are one and the same person. Name listings as such often promote duplications.

THE GARDENER NEEDS ONE LIST - ONE LIST ONLY! Any more is a waste of your chairman's time, club's postage and more times than not the Federation's postage as well.

DATE DUE: On or before June 15th.

ADDRESS CHANGES:

For the Gardener to complete a change of address request, the OLD ADDRESS AND ZIP CODE must be included as well as the new. Be sure to enclose 25¢ for each change whether it is name, address or a combination of both. Example: Jane Jones weds Sam Smith and moves across town. She gets the works for 25¢. Martha Morris moves next door - her change is only 25¢, also.

DISBANDING CLUBS OR CIRCLES

When a club or circle disbands, the full membership list, which includes mailing address and zip codes, should be mailed to the Gardener immediately. If the club or circle is unable to do this, possibly the District Director should forward the information.

LIFE MEMBERSHIPS

The Florida Gardener is interested in FFGC's Life Memberships and these individuals should be listed as such along with their assigned numbers. Example:

Please send original copy of list on forms provided for your convenience. This will insure that all members receive their Florida Gardener promptly.

TREASURERS

The Treasurer is the fiscal officer of the club or circle. She is responsible for handling all club funds and keeping accurate records of receipts and disbursements. Organizations are sometimes required to file certain forms with state and federal agencies and it is usually the Treasurer's responsibility to handle the filing of these forms.

All club or circle books should be audited at the end of your fiscal year. In small clubs or circles this is usually done by a committee of three. Larger clubs sometimes use a professional.

Read the By-Laws of your club or circle and follow them exactly. This will insure that you are operating as prescribed in your By-Laws.

The following information will answer questions most often asked by Presidents and Treasurers regarding fiscal responsibilities -- where to send funds -- deadlines and where and how to file the various forms required by our state and federal government.

1. DUES TO FFGC

When are dues payable? On June 1st of each year.

What period does this cover? From June 1st of the current year through May 31st of the following year. EXAMPLE: June 1, 1979 through May 31, 1980.

On whom are dues paid? On each member on your roster except LIFE MEMBER OF FFGC. A life member in another state still must pay FFGC dues. If a Life member of FFGC retains membership in more than one club, which club takes the exemption? The life member selects the one club to claim this exemption. FFGC or National Life Membership does not exempt a member from local club or circle dues.

Delinquent dues? Dues are delinquent on November 1st.

How much are FFGC dues? Annual dues are \$2.50 for each member or \$3.00 for a husband and wife membership. After January 1st one-half year dues are \$1.25 for each member or \$1.50 for husband and wife. (The above dues effective June 1980.)

When do circles pay dues on new members? As soon as they join the club or circle. Pay their dues to your Club Treasurer so that she can send them to Mrs. O. Fenton Wells (Polly), FFGC Assistant Treasurer.

PROCEDURE FOR PAYING DUES: Make two lists of your entire paid-up membership with their correct mailing address, including ZIP and FLORIDA GARDENER code (please put an "*" before the names of new members and "C" before those with changes from last year). 2. Figure how much the dues are. 3. Make the check for dues payable to "Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc." and mark your District number on the check. 4. Make another check payable to the "Florida Gardener" for 25¢ for each change of address - (please DO NOT send this check to the Assistant Treasurer). 5. THE FLORIDA GARDENER

Members of each FFGC club or circle are entitled to a copy of THE FLORIDA GARDENER. To achieve this, members' names are submitted to the Circulation Department at Headquarters by your club so that they may be processed accordingly on our computer list.

To aid the Circulation Department perform expeditiously, be sure to submit the names ALPHABETICALLY together with their MAILING ADDRESSES.

ALL changes whether they are addresses, names, deletions, etc., must be reported by the club to the FLORIDA GARDENER Circulation Department with a nominal fee of 25¢ each. Members must report any changes to their club. We mail THE FLORIDA GARDENER by second class mail which the Post Office does not forward. Issues not delivered are returned to FFGC at a cost of 25¢ per copy. FFGC pays the Post Office hundreds of dollars annually for this avoidable situation.

Members who have two addresses either in Florida or up North, must be sure to let their chairmen know when they will be moving so that the clubs can advise the Circulation Department in plenty of time so that they won't miss any of the issues. These changes also require a 25¢ fee.

Since we converted to a computer, NEW code numbers were assigned to your club/circle. These will appear in the new BOI's. If you already know your new code number, please be sure to use it on all correspondence, forms, etc. Otherwise, continue to use the old one. Following is a sample of what the new numbering system looks like:

CIRCULATION INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Enclosed are: 1) Two (2) computer print-out membership lists for your club.
 - 2) Membership Forms C-2 and D-3
- B. Correct both copies of the membership lists in the following manner:
 - 1) Use Form C-2 (one for each circle if on circle plan) to ALPHABETICALLY TYPE OR BLOCK PRINT any changes, corrections, new members and FFGC Life Members. Be sure ADDRESSES ARE COMPLETE and include CLUB CODE. See Current Book of Information.
 - 2) Mark deletions with a "D".
 - 3) Mark change/correction in name or address with "C".
 - 4) Mark new members with "N".
 - 5) Mark Life Members with "LM". Please report all deletions with reason for deletion and include LM number. An LM may be dropped from the club, but cannot be dropped from the FFGC Life Membership file unless the member is deceased.
- C. Sometimes members belong to more than one club, therefore are entitled to an issue for each club in which they are listed. Please check with these members with regards their receiving more than one copy of THE FLORIDA GARDENER.
- D. Make one check, payable to THE FLORIDA GARDENER to cover changes. 25¢ for each change/correction. No charge for deletions or new members.
- E. Form D-3 is used for remitting dues for members joining after initial dues payment.
- F. Before June 20, return:
 - 1) One copy of the computer print-out membership list. (Keep the other for your use during the year).
 - 2) Form C-2
 - 3) A check to cover changes.

Members having a seasonal change in address must advise Circulation at least six weeks in advance if member is to continue to receive THE FLORIDA GARDENER. (Requires 25¢ change of address fee each time).
