POWER COMPANIES FAIL TO SETTLE ON LINE USE

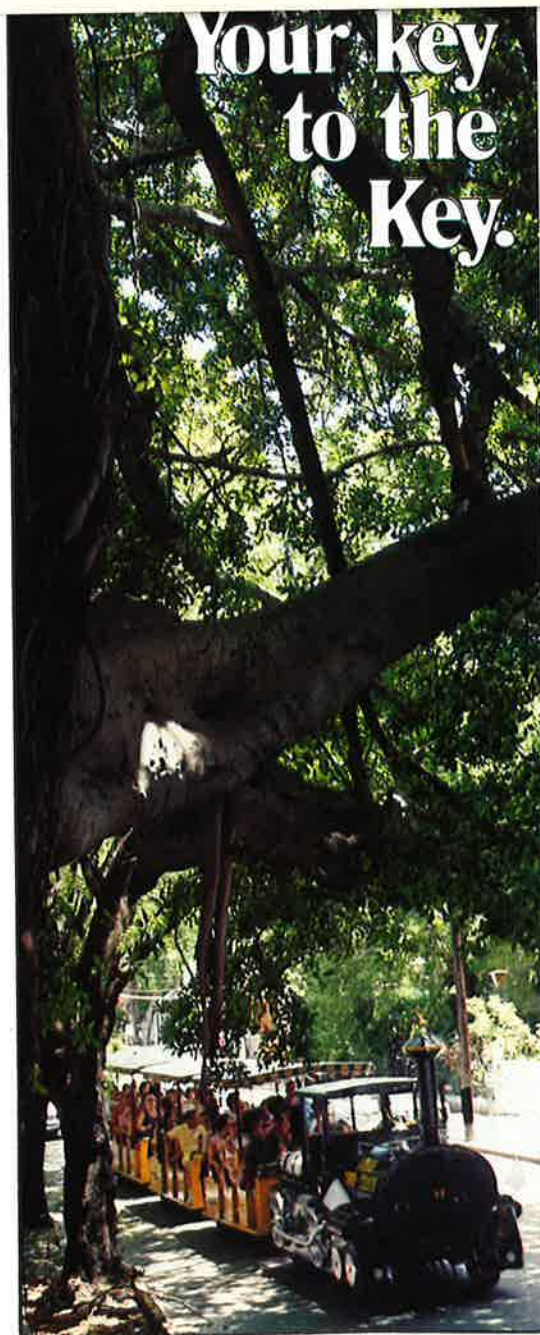
At press time the Florida Keys Electric Co-op and City Electric Service of Key West have failed to come to an agreement for CES to use the FKEC lines to tie into the Florida-Georgia power grid so Key Westers would be able to buy cheaper power and eliminate the costly operation of the old CES generating plant. Co-op execs say they had never included that possibility in their planning and construction and fear the present lines could not safely handle the load.
