ART SHOW 1986 CHAIRMAN REPORT

A very complete report was made in 1985 by Luci Niebler. Refer to that plus the daily diary of Florence Long, 1986.

This project should have co-chairmen and some publicity releases must be out in June because magazines work ahead. See Diary for specific publications and dates. Artist mailings of flyers begin in July and continue as lists and names are obtained. Purple Isles, Homestead Art Guild and other organizations should be contacted for their lists. Visit shows and pass out flyers. Getting artists is the first priority!

In Aug. and Sept. local businesses must be solicited to contribute to our ads in local papers. They get a credit line on our ads. Be prepared with costs when you meet with them. Publicity is the most important part of a successful show. Artists need to know about it and be contacted to sign up. The public must know about it so we have good attendance. We have road signs in the storeroom. The black wood one should be put up before Island Jubilee. The two with arrows are for the roadsides on the day of the show.

Raffle prize solicitation should begin in Sept. We had 5 prizes this year.

Food chairman should contact Jacque Brown re hot dogs in Sept. (see Food report). Also get help for Show day.

Plant chairman should ask at meetings for plants and get help for Show day.

Raffle chairman should check on tickets (we have a roll in the storeroom) and get kelp for Show day.
