







Master Bedroom—An air of elegance and comfortable living are exemplified by the Master Bedroom and its surrounding rooms. The Dressing Room has an English 18th century SHERATON DRESSING TABLE, and a CHIPPENDALE FOUR PANEL FOLDING SCREEN, English, early 19th century which compliment the CHIPPENDALE FOUR-POSTER BED, Duchess of Kent Collection, 1780; the CHIPPENDALE CHEST OF DRAWERS, Duchess of Kent Collection, 1790; and the CHIPPENDALE COMMODE WITH PULL OUT FRONT, 1790. The inside bathroom adjoining the bedroom contains a woman's sit-tub, a unique 18th century COVERED BIDET and other bathroom fixtures.



**Phoebes**—Special exhibitions dealing with Audubon, fine art, and the history and natural resources of the Florida Keys are shown periodically in the second floor gallery. On a regular basis the gallery houses a rare collection of astonishingly detailed porcelain birds and foliage made by artist Dorothy Doughty in collaboration with the Worcester Royal Porcelain Company Limited, Worcester, England.
