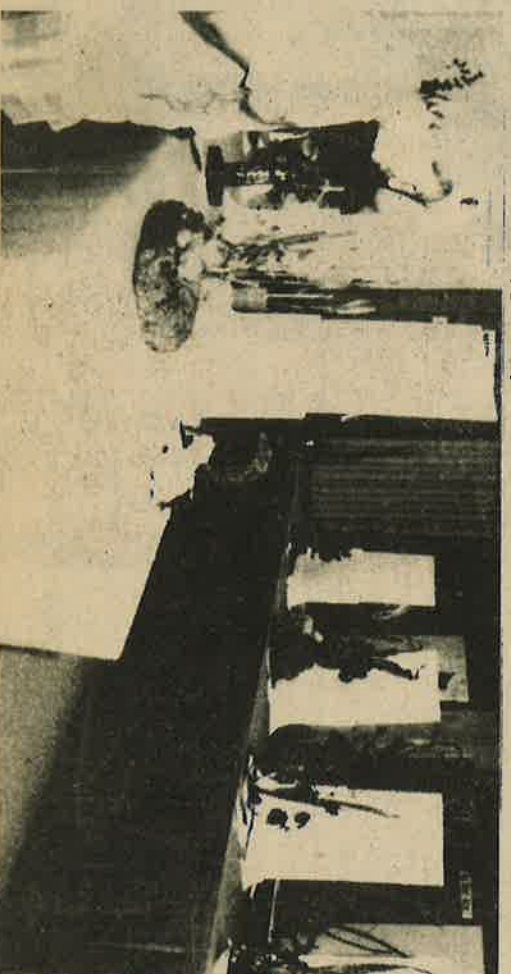
With a theme signifying the beauty of the Keys, awards were presented in a number of categories including both artistic and horticulture divisions.
