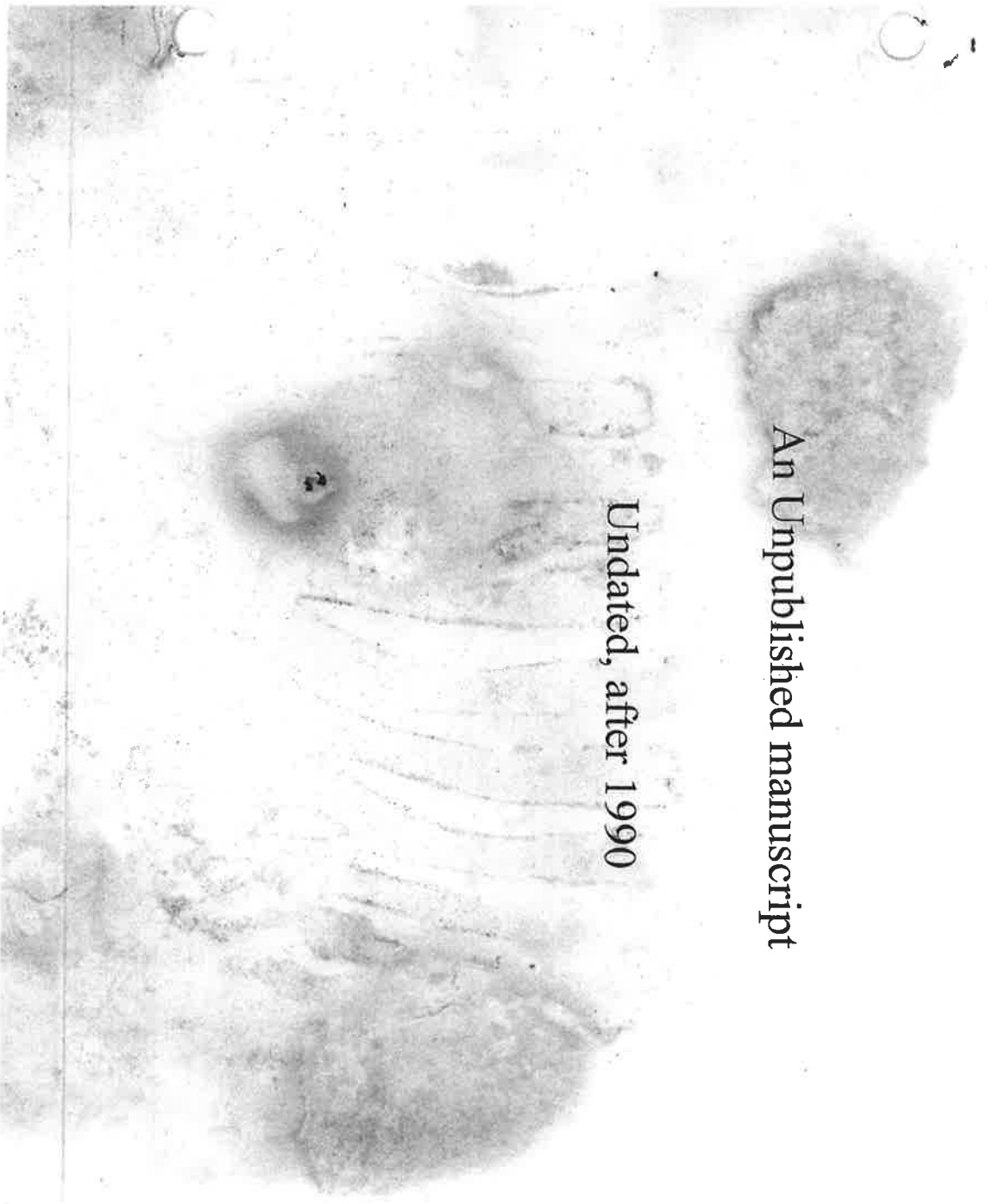


PROJECTILE POINT FROM QUAIL CREEK

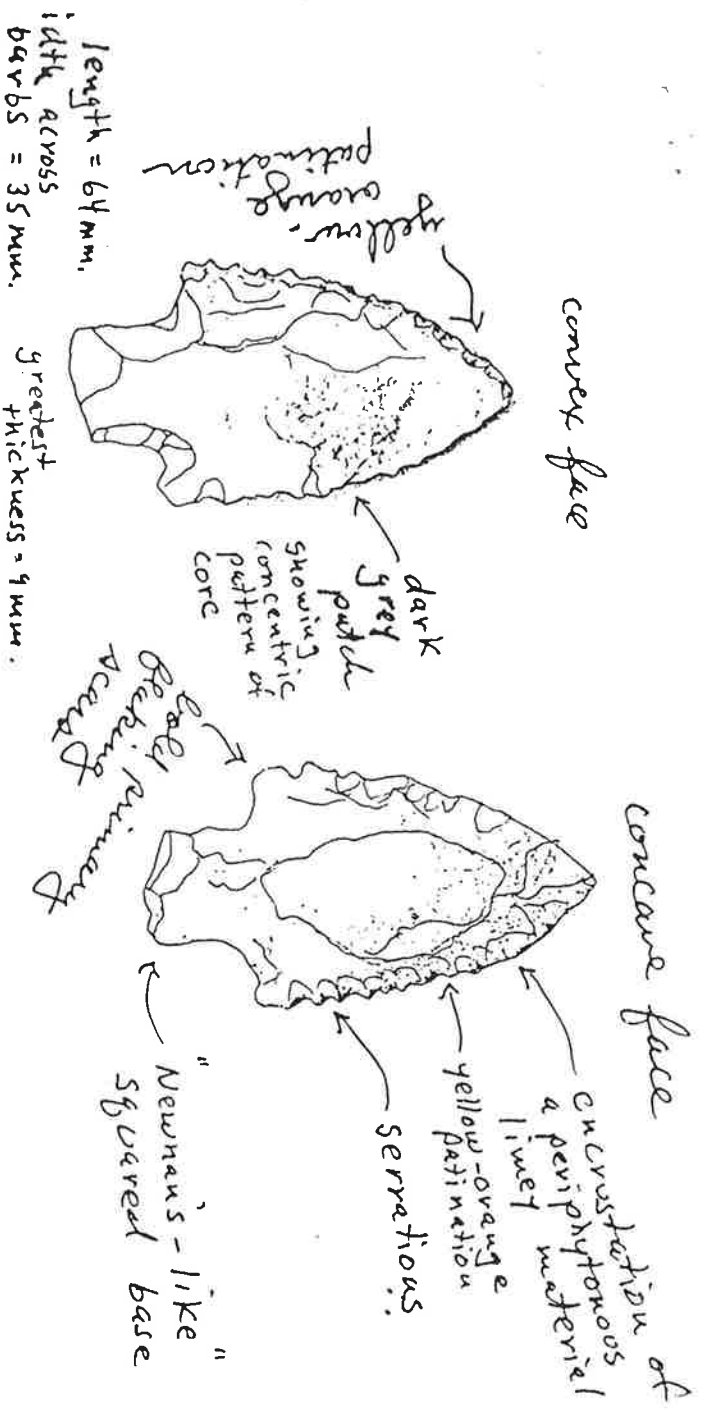

Projectile point found by a friend of Dr. H. E. Bocher at 8th hole of Quail Creek County Club c. December, 1990. The "projectile point" may also have functioned as a knife blade due to unilateral leveling on concave face as well as prominently chipped side - on that same face - which would produced by secondary or "pressure" flaking. The style is (mid) Archaic stemmed - probably a variant on Newman's type - and possibly contemporaneous with the Bay West site (ca. 200) which lies 1 mile east of the find. Material was siliceous chert - probably struck from near the center of a chert nodule or core. Stone comes from Tampa Bay / Hillsborough River area.
