Florida Keys Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), are pleased to announce the DAR Good Citizens Program in the Key West High School, Marathon High School, Coral Shores High School and the Island Christian School, all in Monroe County. The National Association of Secondary School Principals has placed this program on the Advisory List of National Contests and Activities for 1985-86.

Mrs. "K" Wilkinson, Chapter Chairman, in notifying the principals of these high schools says the girls and boys of the Senior Class are eligible to participate. The faculty chooses three seniors who best exemplify outstanding qualities of *Leadership*, *Dependability*, *Service* and *Patriotism* in their school, home and community.

From these three, the Senior Class chooses the School Good Citizen. The student selected as the school's DAR Good Citizens must be a citizens of the

United States of America. *Leadership* includes personality, self-control, ability to assume responsibility; *Dependability* to include truthfulness, loyalty, punctuality; *Service* which includes cooperation, courtesy, consideration of others and *Patriotism* to include unselfish interest in family, school, community and nation, to an outstanding degree.

Each school winner will receive the Good Citizens Pin, Certificate framed and signed by the school principal and state & national Regents, and a wallet card to show they won this outstanding citizens award.

The winners will be invited to a chapter meeting at which time they will report on their school activities, plans for the future, hobbies and any special interests. . .all of which they were graded on to receive this special award.
