Florida Federation of Garden Clubs Award Rules 2013 – 2015

All Florida Federation of Garden Clubs Awards can now be found on the FFGC website (www.ffgc.org). They will no longer be published in this Book of Information (BOI). This change has been made to assure that all FFGC members have full access to the Awards. It will also allow changes and additions to the Awards to be made throughout the year as they may occur.

The Awards will be categorized as follows: FFGC Awards; Youth Awards; Flower Show and Related Awards. Deep South Region and National Garden Clubs Awards may be found on their respective websites: Deep South Region (www.dsregion.org); National Garden Clubs (www.gardenclub.org). The forms for these awards are consistent with the FFGC award forms and may be found on the websites. NGC devised ONE Scale of Points by which most awards are to be evaluated. FFGC has simply fallen in line with the lead of DSR and NGC. Awards have been streamlined and now it is easier than ever before to apply for awards – and (for Florida's NGC/DSR Chairman) to send FFGC winners on to DSR and NGC for further competition when merited.

Major changes you will notice:

- 3-page Awards Application (except as noted)
- One Basic Scale of Points (for most awards)
- Changes in some awards to match NGC or DS requirements
- Awards now online at www.ffgc.org
- Awards applications to be sent to FFGC Headquarters by December 1 (except as noted)

The Awards Committee hopes these changes will help clubs as they apply for awards. As with any endeavor when major changes take place, there will be a learning curve. Further changes may take place as we strive to streamline the awards program. All changes will be published on the website, which is the first resource that should be consulted when applying for awards.

AWARD RULES

- **1. Awards Year**: January 1 to December 31 annually unless otherwise stated. All awards may be presented annually, if merited. Any exceptions will be noted.
- 2. Eligibility:
- A. Only clubs, circles, groups of clubs and individuals who are members of FFGC in good standing are eligible to apply UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.
- B. A group of clubs is defined as: federation of clubs, council club on the circle plan or neighboring club.
- C. High school, intermediate, junior clubs, other youth groups, or individual youth must be sponsored by member club(s) or circle(s).
- 3. Application Forms: FFGC has a NEW application form and procedure for applying for awards. The application form which is available online, should be used for all awards. Your

District Awards Chairman can provide an application form in "Microsoft Word" that may be easier to work with.

Address topics listed on the Scale of Points for each award along with any supporting data and photographs. If no Scale of Points is listed, use the Basic Scale of Points at the end of the Awards Rules.

- There is a three (3) page limit, using only the front of the page. (FFGC application form plus 2 additional pages.—Some exceptions are noted in awards rules.)
- Binders and vinyl sheet protectors are no longer required or allowed. Staple the three
 pages together at the upper left corner.
- Applications will not be returned. Exceptions noted.
- Applications are to be mailed directly to the FFGC Awards Chairman, FFGC
 Headquarters (1400 S. Denning Drive, Winter Park 32789-5662).. Exceptions are
 noted with specific awards. (Hardcopy only: No electronic submissions except as
 noted) Chairmen may request electronic versions.
- Computer generated entries are advised. If the preparer is deficient in computer skills, entries may be cut and pasted by hand. However, a clear, color <u>copy</u> of the hand-generated entry should be mailed. Since entries will not be in binders or plastic sleeves, glued or taped documentation could fall off or be lost.
- Forms are available on the FFGC website (<u>www.ffgc.org</u>) or upon request from the FFGC Awards Chairman or FFGC Awards Coordinator. An FFGC Award application in "Microsoft Word" is available from your District Awards Chairman.
- This NEW application form should <u>not</u> be used for Flower Show Achievement Awards, or NGC Awards of Excellence (NGC Awards 23, 24, and 25.)
- 4. Deadlines and procedure for applying: The application form and documentation for all adult FFGC Awards must be sent to FFGC Headquarters to arrive on or before December 1 except as noted. Exceptions noted below. Complete the application form. Submit the entry (3 pages only) to FFGC Headquarters. Keep one copy for your records. Send a copy of the first page of the application to your District Awards Chairman.
- 5. Exceptions to either date due or where award is to be sent.
