Keys DAR group honors Bicycle Center flag display

The Florida Keys chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution on Wednesday presented Charles Robinson, owner of The Bicycle Center, with a certificate commending his display of the

American flag at his store on Truman Avenue.

The award, made in conjunction with the national society's policy of supporting activities to make all Americans flag-conscious through flag exhibits and other patriotic

displays and activities, is part of a current Keys chapter effort to encourage businesses and other organizations and individuals to display the national colors within view of U.S. 1, the first national highway.

This program, which began at the eastern end of the Keys, has reached Mile Marker 89.

"When we heard of Mr. Robinson's magnificent flag on U.S. 1 so near the southern end of the highway," said Mrs. Jean Barnes Butts, chairman of the chapter's Flag Committee, "we felt we should make an exception to our planned east-to-west sequence and recognize his contribution at once."
