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

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

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CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

KEY LARGO GARDEN CLUB
Organized January 20, 1955
As Amended June 16, 1966

CONSTITUTION

Article I

Name

The name of this organization shall be,
KEY LARGO GARDEN CLUB.

Article II

Object

The object of this Club shall be to promote helpfulness among its members in the study of practical gardening, to maintain the highest standards of excellence in all branches of horticulture, to arouse public interest in landscaping art, and to protect and conserve the natural resources of South Florida.

Article III

Membership

The membership of this Club shall consist of men and women interested in horticulture and landscaping gardening.

ARTICLE IV

Officers

The officers of this club shall be; President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, and Librarian.

ARTICLE V

Amendments

The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the Club by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided such amendments have been read at a previous meeting of the Club.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

Dues

Section 1.
The yearly dues of this Club shall be \$7.00.

Section 2.

Dues shall be payable January of each year.

ARTICLE II

Section 1.

There shall be one regular meeting each month (except during June, July and August), to be held on the third Thursday at 1:00 p.m., unless changed by action of the Executive Board, due notice of which shall be given to members.

ARTICLE 11 (Continued)

Section 2.

Special meetings may be called by the President or Executive Board in absence of the President. Notice of special meetings and their purpose shall be given in advance.

Section 3.

The regular meeting in March shall be the Annual Business Meeting.

Article 111

Section 1. Quorum

Two-thirds of the members present shall constitute a quorum.

Section 2.

Three members at the Executive Board meetings shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE IV

Duties of Officers

Section 1.

The President shall preside at all meetings, appoint special committees, appoint with the approval of the executive Board all standing committees and shall be a member ex-officio of all committees.

Section 2.

The 1st Vice President shall preside at the meetings in the absence of the President and shall perform the duties of the President.

ARTICLE IV (continued)

Section 3.

The Second Vice President shall preside at the meetings in the absence of the President and the First Vice President or upon their request and shall perform the duties of the President.

Section 4.

The Recording Secretary shall take the minutes of all meetings and shall have charge of all papers pertaining to this office.

Section 5.

The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct the correspondence of the Club, keep a complete list of the names and addresses of members, and give notice of the meetings.

Section 6.

The Treasurer shall receive all money and make all disbursements subject to the approval of the Club. She shall collect all dues, keep a correct list of members who have paid their dues, notify members who are in arrears. Only members whose dues have been paid for the current year may serve as officers, chairmen of committees or members of committees.

Section 7.

The Librarian shall have custody of all publications, books, and documents belonging to the Club and shall keep an accurate record of those to whom such papers may be loaned.

ARTICLE IV (Continued)

Section 8.

The Officers of the Club shall constitute the Executive Board.

Section 9.

Any officer or committee chairman, unable to serve in the office to which elected or appointed shall offer resignation in writing.

Section 10.

All vacancies among the officers shall be filled for the unexpired term by the unanimous vote of the Executive Board.

Section 11.

All terms of office shall be for one year. No officer shall be eligible for more than two consecutive years for the same office UNLESS requested to and elected to office by the entire membership present at the election meeting in March.

Section 12.

Upon expiration of his or her term of office, each officer shall give to her successor all books and records that belong to that office.

Section 13.

Executive Board meetings shall be called at the discretion of the President, or in her absence the First Vice President, or Second Vice President.

ARTICLE V Elections

Section 1.

At the meeting in February, the President shall appoint a nominating committee of three members. This committee shall send to the Recording Secretary a list of nomination of Officers for the coming year, after securing the consent of the nominees. Additional nominations may be made from the floor providing the nominee is present or their consent has been obtained.

Section 2.

The election of officers shall take place at the March meeting and shall be by ballot if there is more than one candidate for any office. However, if there is but one candidate for any office, by motion from the floor the election may be by voice.

Section 3.

Installation of the new officers shall be made at the April meeting.

ARTICLE VI

Bills

Section 1.

All bills must be presented by the person incurring them. They must be approved by the Club or in an emergency by the President before they can be paid by the Treasurer.

Section 2.

All checks shall be signed by two officers, the President and Treasurer, or other designated officers.

ARTICLE VI (Continued)

Section 3.

In the event of the death of a member or their spouse, a floral spray or other memorial not exceeding \$15.00 in cost shall be sent in the name of the club. In the event of illness of a member or their spouse, the Corresponding Secretary or the devotional chairman will send a card.

ARTICLE VII

Membership

Section 1.

Anyone wishing to join the Club must be invited by a member in good standing who shall endorse the applicant for membership and present the proposed member in person at one meeting of the Club. The name of the proposed member shall then appear on the notice of the next regular meeting. If there are no objections the proposed member shall become a regular member in good standing upon payment of dues.

Section 2.

Dues are due and payable January 1st. If dues remain unpaid March 1st, member will be notified of their delinquency; and if they remain unpaid April 1st, membership will be cancelled.

Section 3.

Honorary membership may be conferred on any person for outstanding interest or achievement in horticulture and allied subjects. The name of such person must be submitted in writing to the Executive Board for approval. The Board must then recommend the name of

the member at a regular meeting to be approved by two-thirds vote of the members present. Honorary members shall be exempt from payment of dues, but shall not be entitled to vote or hold office. However, upon payment of dues, an honorary member may become an active member with full privileges of the Club.

Section 4.

The privilege of holding office and voting shall be limited to members in good standing.

ARTICLE VIII

Order of Business

The meeting shall be opened with the LORD'S PRAYER, and Honoring of the Flag.

2. Reading of the minutes of the Executive Board meeting.
3. Treasurer's report.
4. Bills.
5. Communications.
6. Presentations of new members and visitors.
7. Committees' reports.
8. Unfinished business.
9. Elections (when required).
