
Dear Mrs. Ballin:

We received your letter of December 16. concerning your claim filed under the Berlin Restitution Law and wish to state the following:

The items you have claimed fall under the Indemnification Law. Insofar the Wiedergutmachungsamt is entitled to reject your claim. However, we suggest that you raise a protest against the decision so as not to neglect anything. At the same time you should file your claim with the Entschadigungsamt in Berlin-Wilmersdorf.

The official forms for such claims are available at our office against payment of \$1.-- per set. Immediately after receipt of \$2.-- we shall send you 2 sets as desired.
