## HOW THE LEAGUE FUNCTIONS

The League takes ACTION on governmental policies and measures in the public interest in conformity with the principles of the League of Women Voters of the U.S. After thorough study it provides information, influences public opinion and supports or opposes legislation. TIME FOR ACTION occurs when League members are asked to express support or opposition on a position after study and general agreement by all Leagues affected by the proposed legislation. CONSENSUS is the term used to indicate membership agreement on an issue. It is determined by the Board after evaluating membership opinion. A LEAGUE POSITION is that body of opinion expressed in consensus appropriately worded by the League Board.

### MEMBERSHIP

All women citizens 18 years of age or older are invited to join. Membership in a local League automatically extends to membership in the County, State and National Leagues. There are approximately 180,000 members in the U.S. and over 190 in the Lake Forest League.

### LEAGUE MEETINGS

General Meetings are held to present an expert speaker on some part of the League program or to provide an opportunity for general discussion or action.

Unit Meetings are small discussion groups to which the study done in Resource Committee Meetings is brought for your consideration. These meetings were designed to bring the program closer to the individual member and to facilitate reaching League consensus. The Discussion Leader makes it possible for all members to participate in an orderly and satisfying manner. Representatives from the Resource Committee are responsible for providing enough facts so that discussion may be informed, accurate, and profitable.

### MEMBERSHIP PARTICIPATION

The League functions most effectively, and the member develops in citizenship, when she participates actively in the work of the League. It is hoped that she will wish to join a resource committee, but in any event her presence at Unit and General Membership Meetings is essential if a true Consensus is to be reached. This year Unit Meetings will be held on Monday and Tuesday mornings. You are welcome to attend the meeting most convenient for you.

## PROGRAM

### LOCAL CURRENT AGENDA 1973-1974

1. A study of the Lake Forest <sup>Support</sup> ~~Master~~ <sup>Official</sup> Plan with emphasis on zoning recreation and safety.
2. A review of the Lake Forest Caucus system.
3. Restudy of township government with emphasis on revenue sharing.

### LOCAL CONTINUING RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Continued study of Lake Forest City Planning with attention focused on land use and local environmental pollution. Action as indicated.
2. Continued attention to public education for Lake Forest, including elementary schools, the high school, and a junior college, with action as indicated.
3. Publication of the League's "Know Your Town" book.

### LAKE COUNTY 1973-1975

1. Continued support for Home Rule for Lake County.
2. Continued support of the concept of planning for health care by the County.
3. Study of watersheds in Lake County.  
Scope: To include flooding problems, flood plain development of the Fox, DesPlaines and Skokie Rivers.

### STATE PROGRAM 1973-75

1. Constitutional implementation—support of measures to implement the 1970 Illinois Constitution.
2. Support of measures to improve the structure and operation of local government to include action on the recommendations of the County Task Force.
3. Support of the individual and his civil rights and liberties.
4. Support of improved services of Illinois State agencies serving children and their families.
5. Support of improved election laws and procedures.
6. Support of a statewide land use policy for Illinois to include a study of how the tax system might be revised to encourage sound land use decisions.
7. Support of improved correctional procedures in Illinois.
8. A study of the distribution of money for public education in Illinois and of alternative methods for financing schools to achieve greater equity for students and tax payers.

# NATIONAL PROGRAM 1972-1974

1. **Environmental Quality:**  
Support of a physical environmental beneficial to life; action to promote wise use of water resources and improvement of water and air quality. Evaluation of solid waste management, including reuse, reclamation and recycling.
2. **Land Use:**  
Evaluation of land use policies and procedures and their relationship to human needs, population trends, and ecological and socioeconomic factors.
3. **Human Resources:**  
Support of equal rights for all regardless of race or sex, with recognition of the special needs of American Indians: action to combat poverty and discrimination and to provide equal access to employment, housing and quality education.
4. **International Relations:**  
Support of policies to promote international cooperation and world peace: action to promote international trade and development efforts, to further normalization of relations with the People's Republic of China and to strengthen the peacekeeping and peacebuilding functions of the United Nations system. Evaluation of current trade patterns and their impact on the U.S. and world economy.
5. **Representative Government:**  
Support of an open governmental system that is representative and responsive:
  - a. U.S. Congress — study of and action for responsive legislative processes.
  - b. Election of the President — action for election of the president and vice-president of the U.S. by direct national popular vote.
  - c. District of Columbia — action for self-government and representation in Congress for citizens of the District of Columbia.
  - d. Apportionment — action for apportionment substantially on population of congressional districts and of all elected state and local governmental bodies.
  - e. Voting Rights (Bylaws, Article XIII, Section 1a) — Action to protect the right to vote of every citizen.
  - f. Alternate methods of financing political campaigns.
