PRINCIPLES OF THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS

The League of Women Voters believes in representative government and in the individual liberties established in the Constitution of the United States of America.

The League of Women Voters believes that democratic government depends upon the informed and active participation of its citizens and requires that governmental bodies protect the citizens's right to know by giving adequate notice of proposed actions, holding open meetings and making public records accessible.

The League of Women Voters believes that every citizen should be protected in the right to vote; that every person should have access to free public education which provides equal opportunity for all; and that no person or group should suffer legal, economic or administrative discrimination.

The League of Women Voters believes that efficient and economical government requires competent personnel, the clear assignment of responsibility, adequate financing and coordination among the different agencies and levels of government.

The League of Women Voters believes that responsible government should be responsive to the will of the people; that government should maintain an equitable and flexible system of taxation, promote the conservation and development of natural resources in the public interest, share in the solution of economic and social problems which affect the general welfare, promote a sound economy and adopt domestic policies which facilitate the solution of international problems.

The League of Women Voters believes that cooperation with other nations is essential in the search for solutions to world problems, and the development of international law is imperative in the promotion of world peace.

HOW THE LEAGUE FUNCTIONS

The League takes ACTION on governmental policies and measures in the public interest in conformity with principles of the League of Women Voters of the U.S. After thorough study, it provides information, influences public opinion and supports or opposes legislation. TIME FOR ACTION occurs when League members are asked to express support or opposition on a position after study and general agreement by all Leagues affected by the proposed legislation. CONSENSUS is the term used to indicate membership agreement on an issue. It is determined by the Board after evaluating membership opinion. A LEAGUE POSITION is that body of opinion expressed in consensus appropriately worded by the League Board.

LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF LAKE FOREST-LAKE BLUFF 1990-1991 PROGRAMS

LOCAL:

1. Study needs of Senior Citizens
2. Lake Bluff Real Estate Tax Study - Task Force on the factors affecting the Real Estate Tax Bill, with the following scope:
 - Investigation of the current and future conditions affecting the taxing bodies represented on the Real Estate Tax Bill.
 - Possible changes affecting the Tax Bill.
3. Continued attention to youth problems and related services.
 - a) Survey of recreational services and facilities for young people in Lake Forest/Lake Bluff and neighboring communities.
 - b) Revise and republish a youth services directory.
 - c) Research and publish compilation of local, county, state and federal laws relating to youth..
4. Continued attention to the needs of young children in Lake Forest/Lake Bluff including but not limited to:
 - a) Revision and republication of the pre-school booklet
 - b) Support for additional pre-school programs, recreation center programs and child care facilities in Lake Forest/Lake Bluff.
5. Support of the 1978 Lake Forest Comprehensive Plan as amended with continuing attention to Land Use, Local Environmental Pollution, Zoning, Recreation and Safety.
6. Continued study of the need for additional pet regulations in Lake Forest; a Leash Law and a Pet Waste Ordinance. Examine the current pet control regulations and assess the need for additional regulations to promote public safety, health and welfare.
7. Continued attention to the Lake Forest Caucus system.
8. Update study on gun control.
9. Continued attention to District 67 elected school board issue.

COUNTY:

1. Study of the use of land in Lake County for composting.
2. Task force to study the need, funding and delivery of services for youth in Lake County.
3. Study of the transportation needs of Lake County.
4. Lake County Jail Task Force.
5. Hazardous Waste Task Force.
6. Solid Waste Task Force.
7. Support Positions on Watershed Management (1975); Land Use in Lake County (1977, revised 1986 & 1988); Solid Waste Disposal in Lake County (1981); Forest Preserve District of Lake County (1988); Lake County Government (1988 & 1989); Future Use of the Ft. Sheridan Property (1990).

STATE:

1. Support of improved services of Illinois state agencies serving children and their families.
2. Support for League positions to implement, amend and uphold the 1970 Illinois Constitution.
3. Support of improved criminal justice procedures in Illinois, alternatives to incarceration and gun control.
4. Support of improved election laws and procedures.
5. Support for a state land use policy that addresses the problem of conflicting uses for the land resources of Illinois.
6. Support for laws which recognize marriage as an economic partnership and for a divorce process which is fair and equitable to all parties with regard to property division, maintenance, custody and child support.
7. Support for comprehensive and coordinated services for mentally ill adults and children in both state facilities and community programs.
8. Support of a public school system that is equitable both in quality for the student and financing for the taxpayer.
9. Support for a diversified and equitable revenue system that provides adequate support for state and local governments, schools, and human services, and that furthers League environmental and land use goals.
10. Establishment of a task force to develop criteria and guidelines for solid waste management based on LWWUS positions.
11. A study with concurrence on selected aspects of the structure of county government.

Writing to Members of Congress

Few people communicate with their elected officials. Your voice is important. A letter represents the view of 100, a telegram 250. Here are some tips to make sure your letter gets the attention it deserves:

1. To set it apart from the thousands of computer generated letters that Congress gets, make your letter as personal as possible, offering your own views on a legislative issue. Often, writing in longhand as opposed to typing will cause your letter to get noticed.
2. Focus on one issue and keep the letter short, preferably no more than a page.
3. The correct salutation for the envelope to U.S. Senators or Representatives is "The Honorable _____". The correct salutation within the letter is "Dear Senator _____" or for Representatives, "Dear Mr./Ms. _____".
4. Identify yourself as a homemaker, attorney, teacher, teenager, salesperson, etc., especially as it relates to the bill you are discussing.
5. Refer to legislation by its title and try to summarize it in the letter. Not everyone in Congress is familiar with every bill.
6. Give your reasons for supporting or opposing a specific bill.
7. Telegrams called Public Opinion Messages may be sent to Congress at any time by calling Western Union at 1-800-325-6000. The charge is about \$9-\$12 depending on length.

Democracy Is Not A Spectator Sport Here's a checklist of a dozen things you can do:

1. Register to vote.
2. Become informed about local, state and national issues.
3. Study candidate qualifications.
4. Distribute literature and assist in organizing candidate forums and debates.
5. Attend city council and board of education meetings.
6. Know the men and women who represent you.
7. Write letters to local aldermen, state representatives and Congressmen or women.
8. Lobby for your beliefs; testify at hearings.
9. Support the League of Women Voters.
10. Participate in League-sponsored studies on topics that interest you.
11. Vote in every primary and general election.
12. Get your spouse or a friend to do Items 1-11.
