HOW THE LEAGUE FUNCTIONS

The League takes ACTION on governmental policies and measures in the public interest in conformity with the principles of the League of Women Voters of the U.S. After thorough study it provides information, influences public opinion and supports of the propose legislation. TIME FOR ACTION occurs where the propose legislation. TIME FOR ACTION occurs where asked to express support or opposition on a position after study or general agreement by all Leagues affected by the proposed COMENNUS is the term used to indicate membership agreement on an issue, fit determined by the Board after evaluating membership opinion. A LEAGUE POSITION is that body opinion expressed in consensus appropriately worded by the league after evaluating membership opinion. A

MEMBERSHIP

All women citizens 18 years of age or older are invited to join. Membership in a local League automatically extends to membership in the County, State and National Leagues. There are approximately 157,000 members in the U.S. and over 170 in the Lake Forest League.

LEAGUE MEETINGS

General Meetings are held to present an expert speaker on some part of the League program or to provide an opportunity for general discussion or action.

<u>Unit Meetings</u> are small discussion groups to which the study done in Resource Committee Meetings is brought for your consideration. These meetings were designed to bring the program closer to the individual member and to facilitate reaching League consensus. The Discussion Leader makes it possible for all members to participate in an orderly and satisfying manner. Representatives from the Resource Committee are responsible for providing enough facts so that discussion may be informed, accurate, and profitishing.

MEMBERSHIP PARTICIPATION

The League functions most effectively, and the member develops in citizenship, when she participates actively in the work of the League. It is hoped that she will wish to join a resource committee, but in any event her presence at Unit and General Membership Meetings is essential if a true Consensus is to be reached. This year Unit Meetings will be held on Monday and Tuesday mornings. You are welcome to attend the meeting most convenient for you.
