The class of '50 began writing its history in the annals of Ravenswood High in September 1946. As Freshmen we were timid and shy, but we managed to smile and become part of the school. We all stayed in a group as we didn't know which way to turn. Under the sponsorship of Mr. Gay Cox and Miss Lettie Gillaspie, the class organized with Dayton Gorrell, President; Leslie Sallie, Vice-president; Dorothy Allman, Secretary-Treasurer; and Nancy Rector, Cheerleader.

As Sophomores we were becoming more acquainted with the students and teachers and found school more pleasant. By now we belonged to most of the clubs and were permitted to participate in school acitivities. Our class sponsors were Mr. Ronald Good and Mrs. Blanche Jarrett. We elected William James, Jr., President; William Morgan, Vice-president; and Opal Holt, Secretary-Treasurer.

After three months vacation we were very anxious to start back to school. As Juniors we were very active and had lots of work to do. We presented the class play, "Till Death Do Us Part" under the direction of Miss Clara Belle Tucker. We also sponsored a Red Devil contest and the contestants coming out as winners were Joan Rowley and Archie Barber. Having money to spare after all these activities, we presented the school with a spot light. We were guided in our activities by Mr. Gay Cox and Miss Phoebe Carpenter and elected Johnny Kelley, President; Nancy Rector, Vicepresident; Sarah Wildman, Secretary; and Dayton Gorrell, Treasurer.

During the present year the class stepped into its role of school leadership and very effectively published the <u>Hi-News</u> and <u>Nautilus</u>; inherited several privileges such as front seats in assembly and class night. Under the direction of Nancy Rector, a Senior Thespian, we ably presented the Christmas play, "Dad Trims the Christmas Tree". Our class play directed by Mr. James Kessel and Miss Clara Belle Tucker was given to a large and appreciative audience. We selected our play, "The Brain Storm".

One of the highlights of our Senior year was the beginning of the Student Council with a member of our class, Johnny Kelley, selected to serve as President. The class of '50 directed by Mr. Kessell and Mrs. Elinore Hutchinson elected the following class officers; Leslie Sallie, President; Nancy Rector, Vice-president; Olive Gorrell, Secretary; and Dayton Gorrell, Treasurer.
