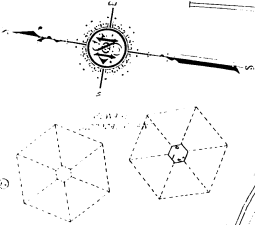

ELOISE INFIRMARY & HOSPITAL

THE INFIRMARY AND HOSPITAL WAS DESIGNED BY ARCHT. HENRY RUFF, JR. AND WAS BUILT BY THE WAYNE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. THE INFIRMARY WAS BUILT IN 1928 AND THE HOSPITAL IN 1930. THE INFIRMARY IS A TWO-STORY BUILDING AND THE HOSPITAL IS A THREE-STORY BUILDING. THE INFIRMARY HAS 20 BEDS AND THE HOSPITAL HAS 30 BEDS. THE INFIRMARY IS USED FOR THE CARE OF CHRONIC CASES AND THE HOSPITAL IS USED FOR THE CARE OF ACUTE CASES. THE INFIRMARY IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF MODERN INFIRMARY DESIGN AND THE HOSPITAL IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF MODERN HOSPITAL DESIGN.
