Abstract

The C.I. Uniform Collection contains several school uniforms from Christiansburg Industrial Institute for extracurricular activities, classes, graduation gowns, and some CIAA reunion merchandise.

Biographical / Historical Note

Christiansburg Industrial Institute was founded as a Freedmen's Bureau school in 1866 by Captain Charles Schaeffer in Montgomery County, VA. The Friends Freedmen's Association provided financial support and management shortly after the Bureau disbanded in 1871. Under the later leadership of African American faculty and staff, the institute grew into a working industrial school that taught academic subjects as well as agriculture, carpentry, blacksmithing, printing, sewing, cooking, and home economics. It also managed the Hill School, a primary and intermediate school.

Uniforms were an important part of school life at Christiansburg Industrial Institute. Christiansburg Industrial Institute's school colors were green and gold which is reflected in many of the school uniforms.

Collection Description

This collection contains uniforms worn by students at Christiansburg Institute for classes, extracurricular activities, and graduation. This includes CI marching band uniforms, cheerleading uniforms, and physical education class uniforms. This collection also includes uniforms worn by Christiansburg Institute teachers and faculty; including coach Tillman's jacket and hat, and a cosmetology uniform. There are also two t-shirts created for the Christiansburg Institute Alumni Association reunion celebrations.
