Abstract

The Smokehouse Collection contains an assortment of objects, photographs, books, and documents related to the historic Christiansburg Industrial Institute.

Biographical / Historical Note

CIAA, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. CIAA's stated purpose in their bylaws is to maintain Christiansburg Institute (CI) as a viable education and service organization through the ongoing organization of its members and their descendants. This purpose has a primary aim of commemorating and sustaining its outstanding achievements and legacy in the education of African Americans enabling them to serve their communities.

CIAA, Inc. is an atypical alumni association for many reasons, but most notably is that there aren't new alumni every year. The last graduating class of CI was in 1966. Ten years after Christiansburg Institute closed, a group of alumni came together and planned a reunion.

CIAA reconstructed the historic smokehouse that was on the Christiansburg Institute property circa 1980s and made it an on site museum to hold their artifacts. This collection is what was on exhibit in the Smokehouse Museum from 1980s-2017. In 2017, the artifacts were removed and placed in a climate controlled environment. The collection now resides at the Christiansburg Institute Museum and Archives with the rest of the archives.
