Abstract

The Tillman R. Sease Collection contains materials related to Christiansburg Institute and Howard University sports coach, Tillman R. Sease.

Biographical / Historical Note

Tillman R. Sease Sr. (September 6, 1916 – September 2, 1988) was an American football and baseball coach with a notable career spanning several institutions. Graduating from Bluefield State College in 1948, he later earned a master's degree in education from Columbia University.

Sease's coaching journey began at Christiansburg Institute in Virginia, where from 1948 to 1956, he served as athletic director and coached football, basketball, and baseball. He ensured its participation in the Virginia Interscholastic Association (VIA), a statewide network for African American secondary schools. Sease's leadership led to CI's success within the VIA, where students competed in academics and athletics. Sease's contributions to CI and the African American community remain integral to its history. He then returned

to Bluefield State in 1956 as an assistant football and basketball coach under Sam B. Taylor before being appointed as the athletic director in 1959.

From 1959 to 1961, Sease served as the head football coach at Bluefield State College, followed by stints at Howard University in Washington, D.C. from 1962 to 1968 and again from 1970 to 1972. At Howard, he also coached baseball.
