Abstract

The Viola Charlton Collection contains her teaching materials, school records, yearbook photographs, and student ephemera from her time teaching at Christiansburg Institute.

Biographical / Historical Note

Viola Charlton was born in Montgomery County, Virginia on May 5, 1905. She earned her B.A. from Virginia State College and her M.A. from Catholic University of America. She taught in Allegheny Springs and Clifton Forge before returning home to Radford. She then taught French and English at Christiansburg Industrial Institute from 1947 until it closed in 1966. She also sponsored French and Forensics clubs, and founded the Drama Club, and sponsored a student each year for the "I Speak for Democracy Contest." She participated in the Christiansburg Institute Alumni Association until her death in 1998.

Collection Description

This collection contains teaching materials from Viola CHarlton's nineteen years at Christiansburg Industrial Institute. They are reflective of her many classes and clubs. Of

particular interest are the original photographs used in the yearbook and the 1963 Self-Evaluation Summaries. The Self-Evaluation Summaries describe the condition of the campus, teaching schedule, offered extracurricular activities, and statistics about classes, graduation rates, etc.
