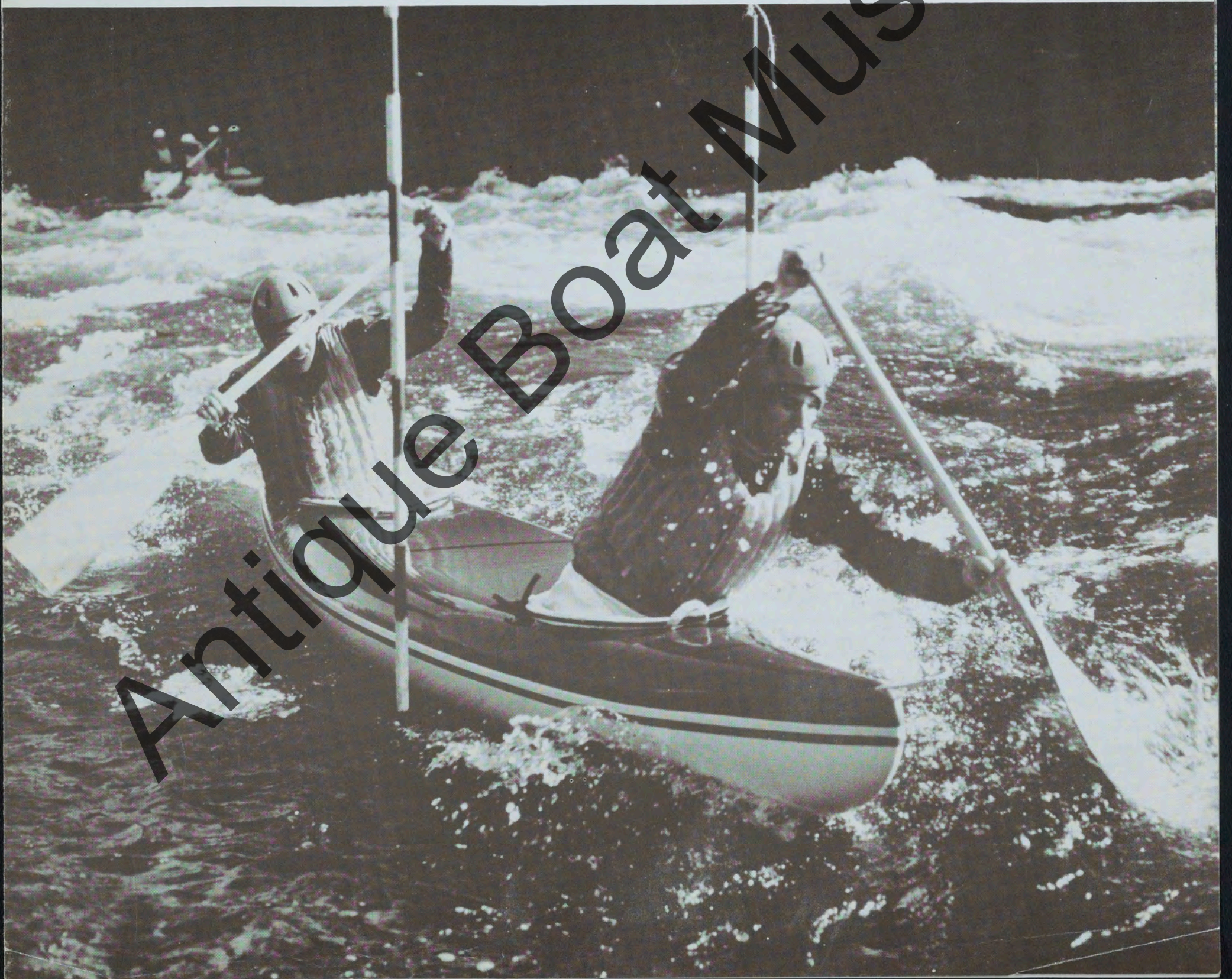


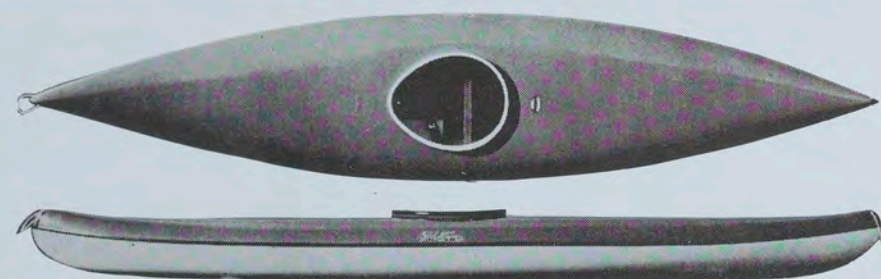
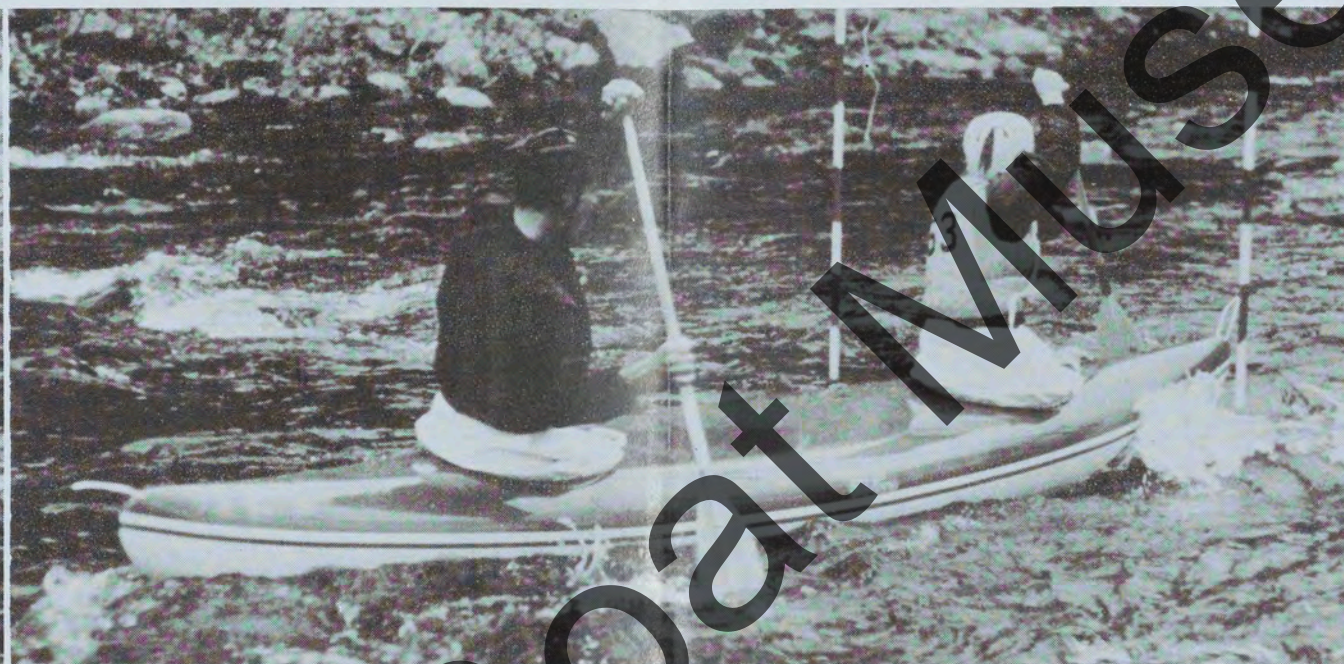

### Old Town C-1 Slalom Canoe

A new mark of wild water excellence

That is it. The Old Town C-1 Slalom Canoe. All the detailing and finishing that goes to make up the finest single-man wild water canoe possible has been given to the C-1. Here is a wild water competition canoe that is unexcelled for speed and ease of maneuverability. The craft has already seen action on the swirling waters of Connecticut's Farmington River; the West River, Vermont and the Loyalsock in Pennsylvania.

In addition to the C-1's competitive nature, this forty-five pound, thirteen foot craft has ample space for duffel, making it a superb canoe well suited for river cruising trips. The Old Town C-1 fully meets the ICF Slalom dimension requirements. Add to this an unusual comfort for a high performance craft, and the C-1 becomes a dream come true.

### Old Town's C-2...

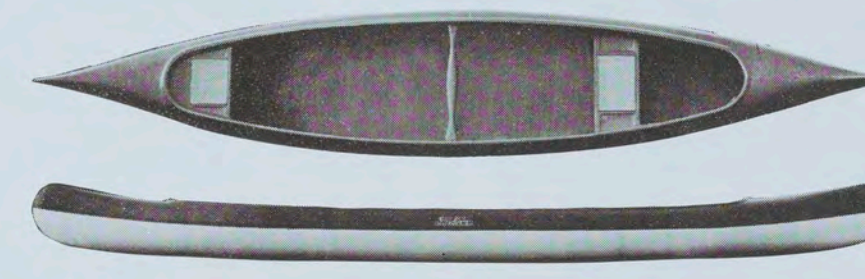
challenges the wildest water

Measuring slightly more than fifteen feet in length, the new C-2 Slalom Canoe is the latest and best word in a two man ICF approved craft. Incredibly fast and maneuverable, the Old Town C-2 is equipped with cockpit rim seats. However, the C-2 may be ordered with pedestal seats at *no extra cost* for those paddlers who enjoy this style seat. Strap seats can also be supplied for those who prefer them. Flotation end bags are available as well as a very large center flotation bag; the latter, however, prevents the hauling of additional gear. All flotation bags are optional. The C-2 has already distinguished itself in several wild-water events. A better craft of its style has yet to be designed.

Standard equipment for the C-2 includes: knee straps and pads, toe braces, cockpit rim seats, bow and stern grab loops. Pedestal seats or strap seats available on special order at no extra cost.

### The Ojibway...

inspired by a mighty people

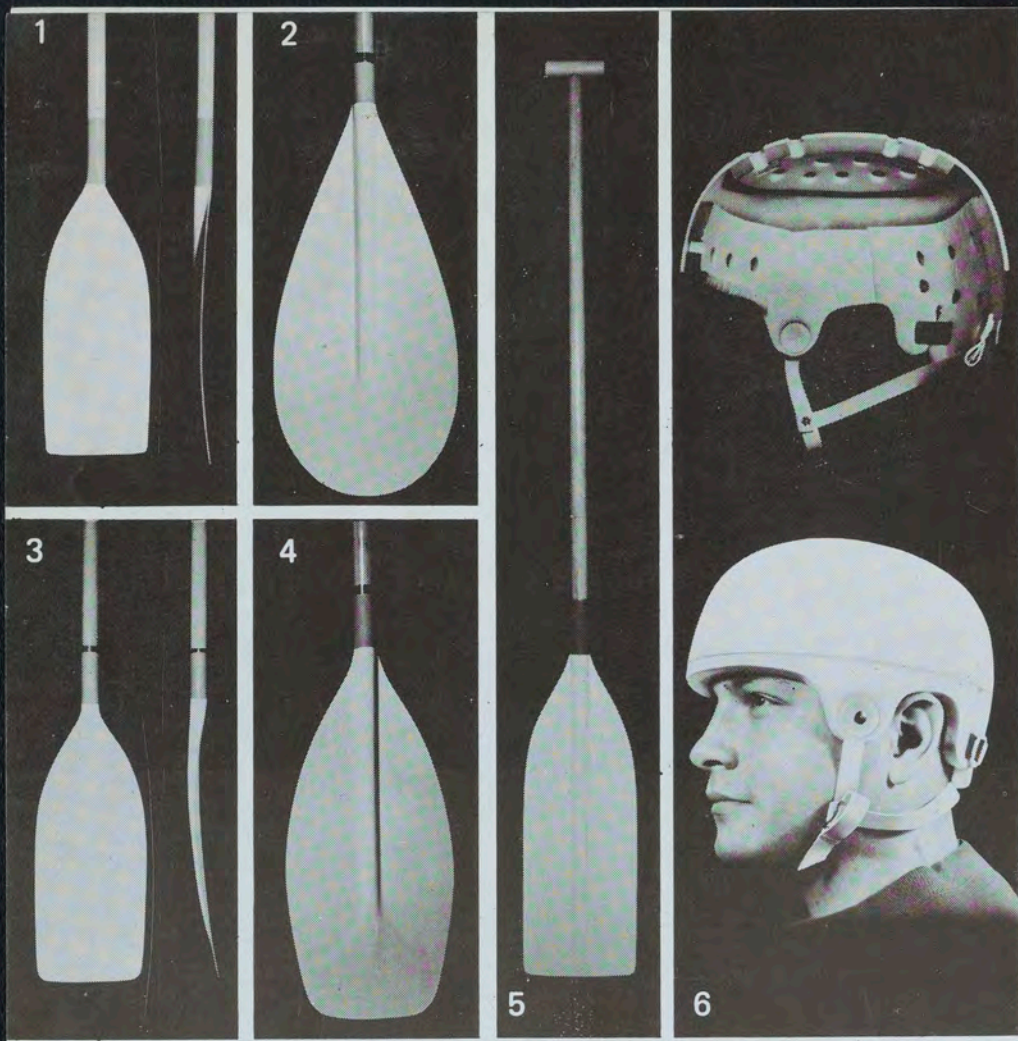
Old Town's "genius" for design has never been better exemplified than in the Ojibway, the latest entry in wild water slalom canoes. Based on some of the remarkable design principles of the Ojibway Indians, the sixteen foot long craft was the winner in the grueling Kenduskeag River Marathon this Spring in Maine.

This 21 1/2 fathom model with a balsa-sandwich core bottom features a parquet floor effect. The Ojibway is supplied without keel and with long decks; flotation is under the gunwales. Portage ease is assisted by the inclusion of a middle thwart. The Ojibway is a major contribution to designing a fine canoe that fully meets wild water specifications, and doubles as a great all-around canoe on lake, river or stream.

**Accessory Equipment** Paddle construction: Two pressure molded, white fiberglass blades feathered at 90 degrees. One piece, straight-grained spruce shafts, finished with three coats of urethane varnish, hand rubbed and waxed. Paddle selection: Experienced white water paddlers prefer spooned blade. In ordering spooned blade paddles, specify for right-hand grip or left-hand grip. With spoon blade double paddle being held by paddler and the right spoon facing paddler, a left-hand grip paddle has left spoon facing down. A right-hand grip paddle has left spoon facing up. Novice paddlers find the flat blade more easily controlled.

**1. Spooned Blade Paddle:** Made in 80, 82, and 84" lengths. Shaft diameter: 1 1/4". Blade area: 7 1/2" x 18". Weight: approximately 3 pounds. Price: \$27.50.

**2. Flat Blade Paddle:** Made in 80, 82, and 84" lengths. Shaft diameter: 1 1/4". Blade area: 9" x 20". Weight: approximately 2 1/2 pounds. Price: \$25.00.

**3. Junior Spooned Blade Paddle:** Made in 76 and 78" lengths. Shaft: 1-3/16". Blade area: 7" x 17". Weight: approximately 2 1/2 pounds. Price: \$24.50.

**4. Junior Flat Paddle:** Made in 76 and 78" lengths. Shaft diameter: 1-3/16". Blade area: 8 1/2" x 19". Weight: approximately 2 1/2 pounds. Price: \$22.50.

**5. Canoe Paddle:** Single blade with T Grip. Made in lengths of 60", 62", 64", 66", 68", 70" and 72". Shaft diameter: 1 1/4". Blade area: 7 3/4" x 23". Weight: approximately 2 1/2 pounds. Price: \$20.00.

**6. White Water Helmet:** Lightweight, washable. White outer shell of high impact Danlite bonded to shock absorbent vinyl-coated Ensolite liner. Protects whole head and back of neck. Floats. 3 sizes: Small, 6 7/8-7; Medium, 7 1/8-7 1/4; Large, 7 3/8-7 1/2. Price: \$15.00 ea.

**Cockpit Covers:** For kayaks and canoes. One piece stretch-on Hypalon. Close up craft while cartopping or in storage. Specify model with order. Price: \$12.00 ea.

**Construction** Old Town Slalom Canoes feature the latest and best hull designs for slalom, downriver, and touring. Hulls feature a sandwich of polypropylene, fiberglass cloth and end-grain balsa, a rigid core of exceptional strength which eliminates the need for ribs. Decks are laminated fiberglass cloth. Grab loops are installed bow and stern.

**Color** Slalom canoes can be ordered in any one of 13 different fiberglass colors and/or combinations for hull and deck. Colors are: Celery, Avocado, Dark Green, Jade Green, Turquoise, Blue, Russet (rust orange), Red, Mahogany, Yellow, Sandalwood, Desert White and White. White hulls show scratches less than colored hulls. Color cards available on request. Psychedelic Breakout pattern available for decks only—\$40.00 extra. Stock colors are Desert White hull with Red, Yellow, or Blue deck. Allow 3 weeks for other color order. Special metal flake Red decks, \$25.00 extra. Special Burma Teak finished decks, \$30.00 extra.

**Orders** In writing your order, specify model, color, price, and accessory equipment. All prices F.O.B. Old Town, Maine. Pricing of white water craft includes packing for shipment. For added protection, particularly for long distances, a carton is recommended. Cost of carton is \$15.00 additional.

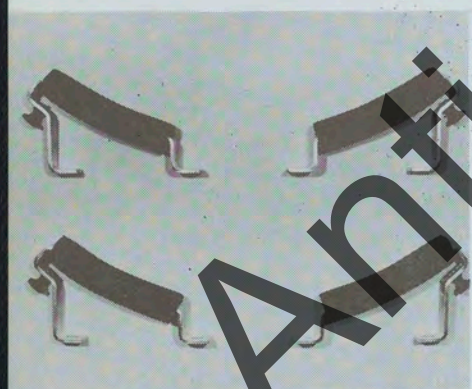

**Spray Skirt** Hypalon with rubber shock cord draw strings. Available for all Old Town kayaks and white water canoes. Color: White. Weight: about 10 ounces. Price: \$16.00 ea. Specify model with order.



**Flotation Bags** Vinyl contour bags with baffle down the middle and double valves. Very light weight. Specify model with order. Set of two for C-1: \$27.50. Set of two for C-2: \$15.00. Large center flotation bag for C-2: \$17.50 each. Small hand pump for quick inflation of bags: \$3.00.
