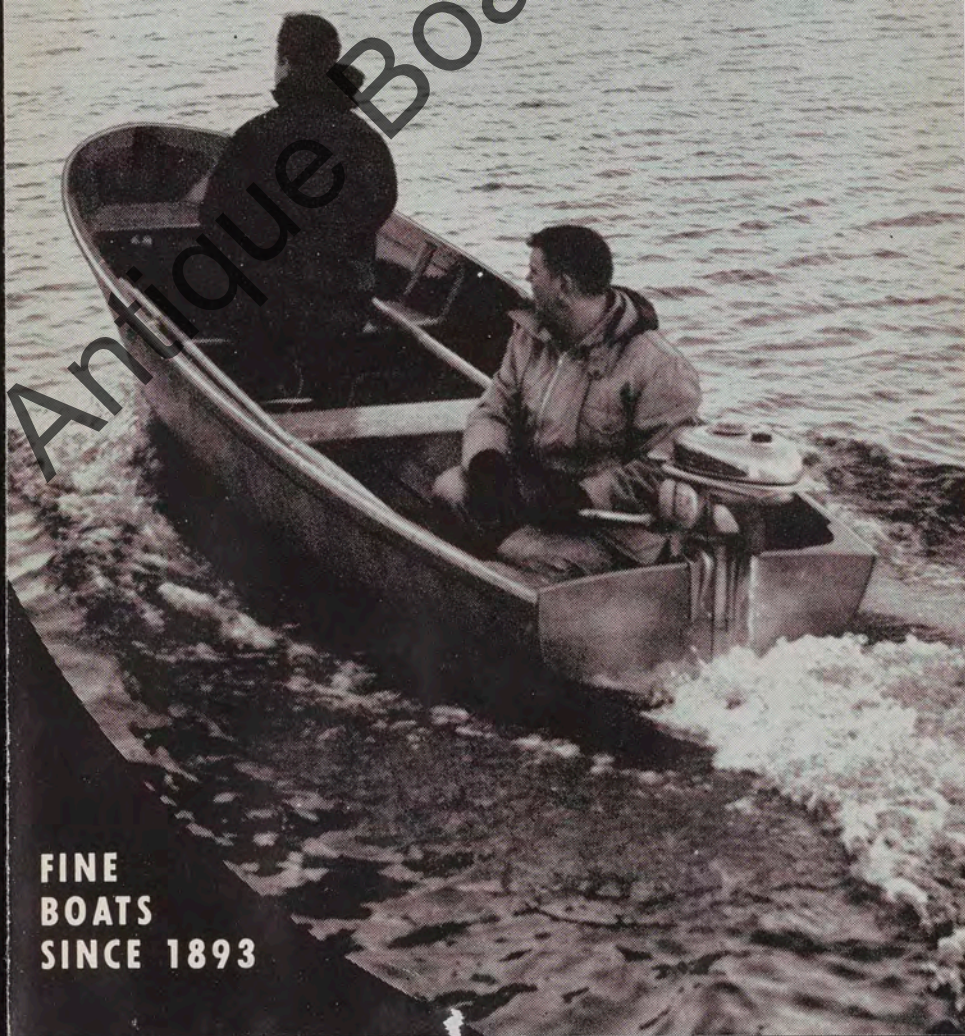

The Hydrolite process, developed after a long period of experimental work and careful tests, is a means of moulding wood and plastics into a one-piece hull absolutely free of stress. No seams — no leaks. Drying out causes no harm. No splitting or checking. Per pound of weight, Hydrolite is far stronger than metal. This boat can "take it" — year after year!

A feature you'll like about Hydrolite is that this new construction allows an unusual design heretofore impossible with conventional wood or plywood con-

struction. Phil Rhodes has made good use of this new liberty to incorporate many new performance features. See, for instance, the conical-shape bow. It is almost circular when viewed from above, but is drawn into a regular pointed bow at the water line. This feature alone means extra carrying capacity — a seat really wide enough for two people, right up in the eyes of the boat. Yet, with oars or outboard motor you have normal performance. And the plus value of this design is greater stability, reserve buoyancy and excellent towing qualities.
