— INSTRUCTIONS TO CERTIFIED MEASURES —

1. The duties of a Certified Measurer are confined to measuring yachts and reporting facts. He has no authority to grant or reject certificates or interpret rules. Complete instructions as to how to measure will be sent to him by the Measurement Committee after his appointment.
2. This Form must be made out by the Certified Measurer IN DUPLICATE. He must answer all questions on page 2, sec. A, and fill in all dimensions called for on diagram. Then file both copies with Measurement Committee.
3. Sails and spars are measured before sanctioned championships, at other times the Fleet is responsible for checking them. Certified Measurers, if authorized by a Fleet, can approve or reject sails or spars. Sails must be marked by Certified Measurer for identification.
4. A Certified Measurer cannot measure a yacht in which he owns an interest except under duly appointed and authorized supervision.

— CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED —

1. This Certificate is not valid unless it bears the inspection stamp of the C. C. Y. R. A. and is signed by the Chief Measurer. It shall be automatically revoked if any structural alterations are made or if not properly endorsed to a new owner by former owner, or may be revoked at any time by order of the Measurement Committee or the Executive Committee of the Comet Class Yacht Racing Association.
2. This Certificate shall be binding upon all members, Comet Fleets, Clubs or organizations conducting races for the Comet Class as such. Sails and spars excepted, the holder of this Certificate shall not be subject to protest on measurements unless an order to remeasure is obtained from the Executive or Measurement Committee, after the protesting party has submitted evidence to show that there are reasonable grounds to suspect subsequent alterations or other justifiable cause.
3. Copies of this Certificate may be obtained from the Measurement Committee for \$1.00. A new Certificate may be obtained after all renewal affidavits on Page 2 are exhausted without charge. A duplicate of every Certificate granted will be kept on file by the Measurement Committee and a list of newly granted Certificates will be published from time to time.
