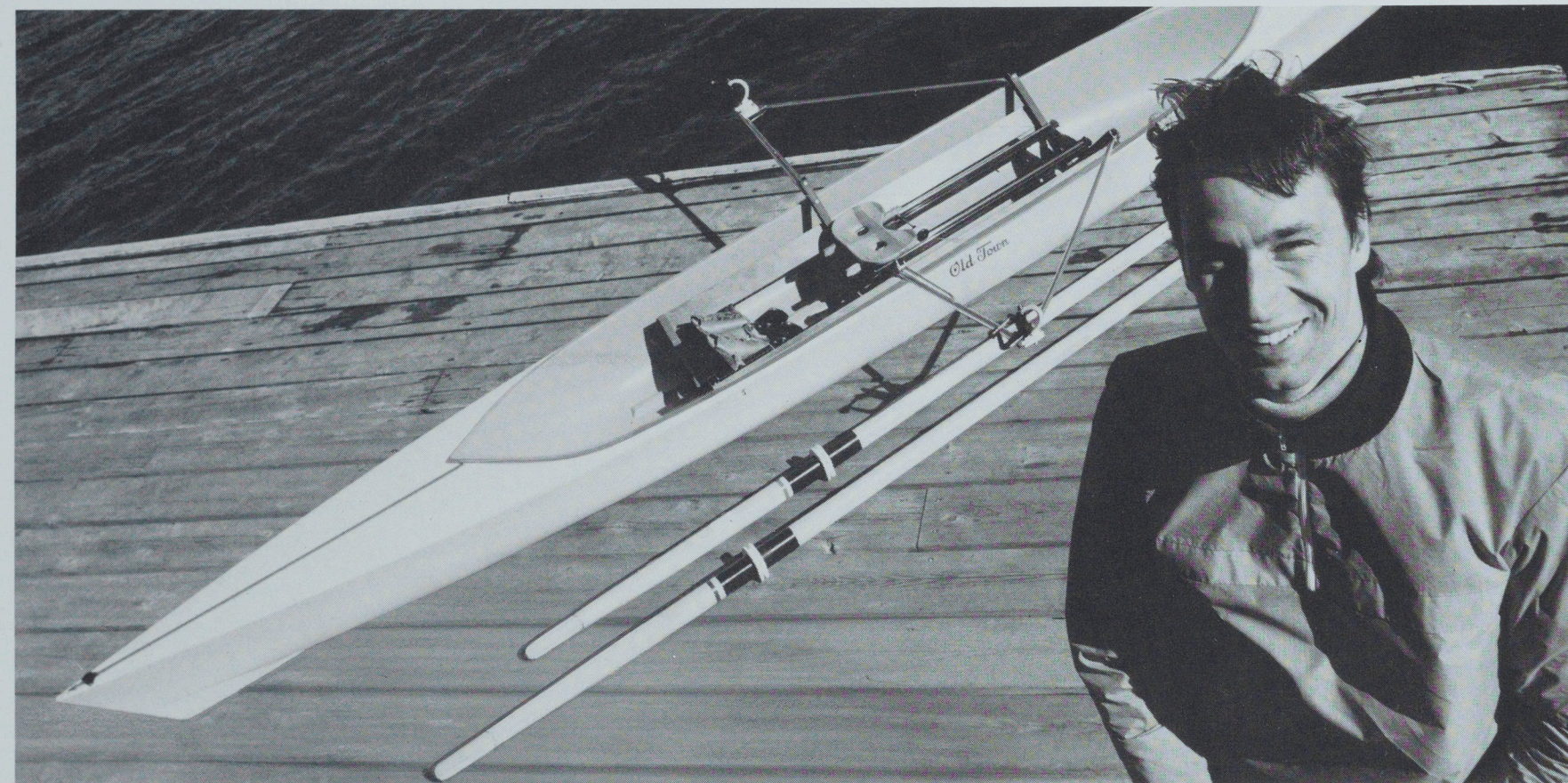

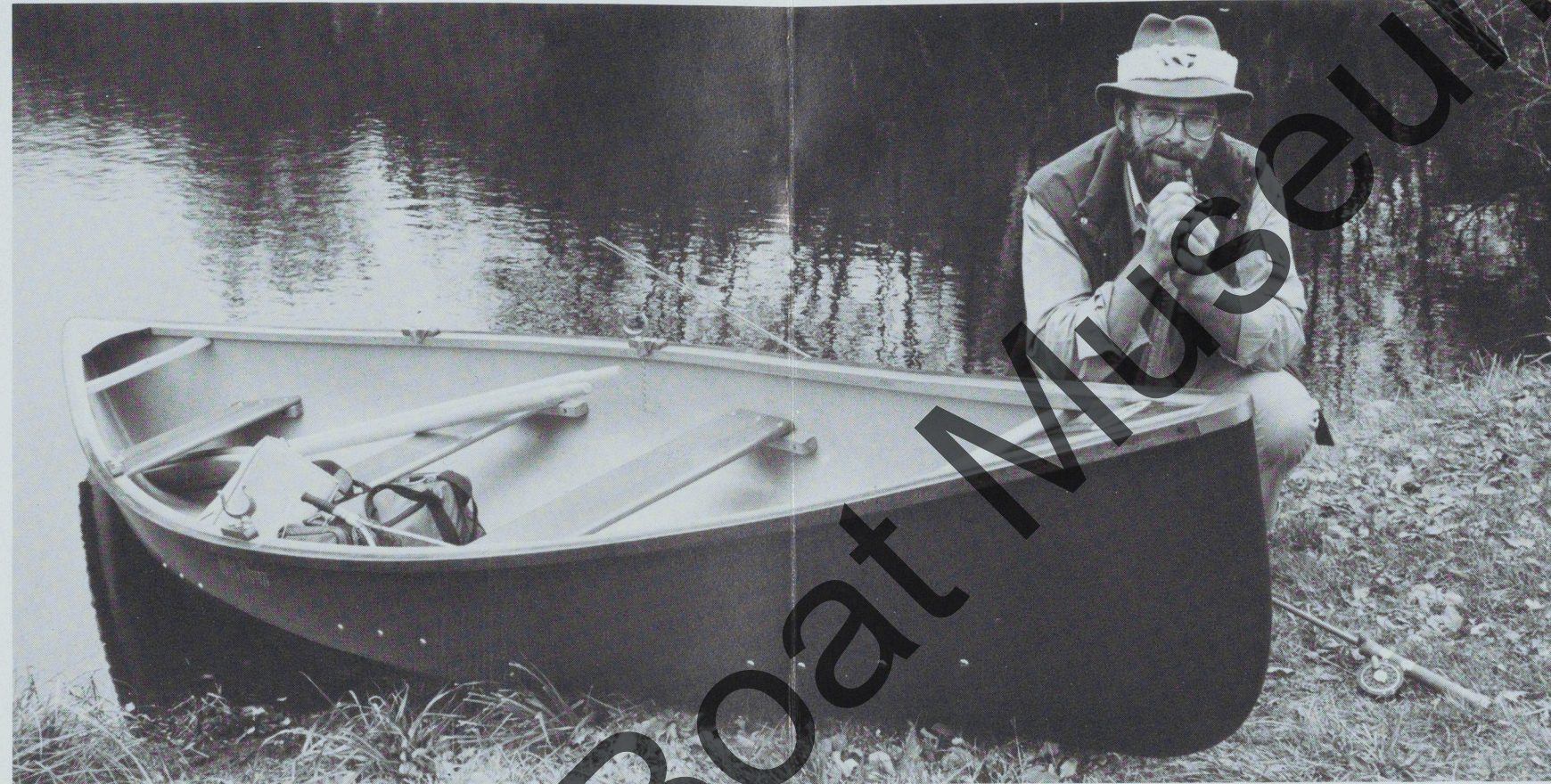


The long-awaited Old Town single rowing shell is finally off the launching pad. Working with various coaches and consultants, and a team of designers at Wing Systems, we fussed with the project for months. We didn't stop until we had a boat we could proudly call an Old Town. For three reasons.

One. It's perfect for beginners. Patient, uncomplicated, an exercise machine second to none.

Two. It's a spunky boat when handled by an experienced sculler. You won't outgrow it.

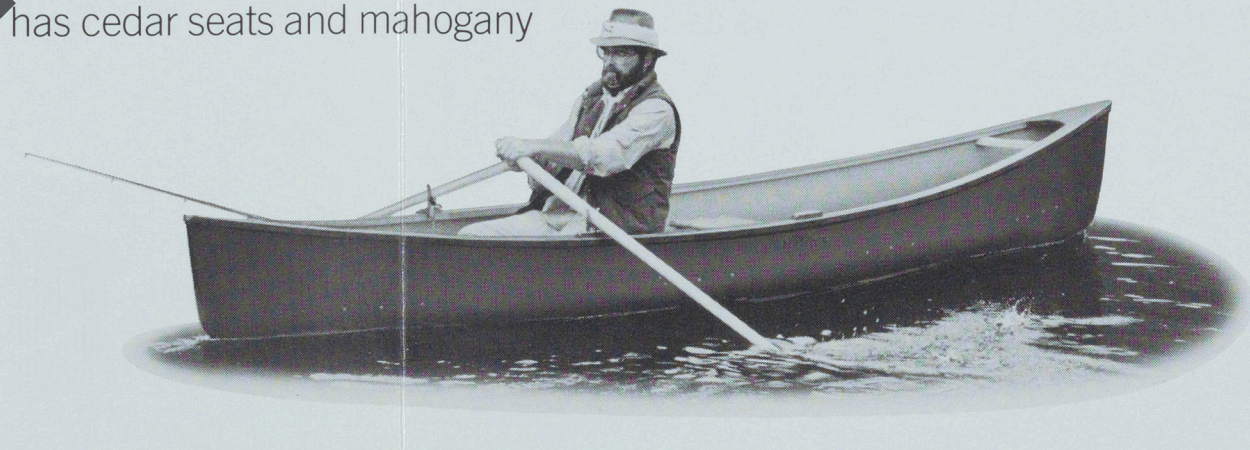
Three. In addition to keeping you aerobically fit, the Old Town rowing shell will keep you comfortable traveling long distance. It's rugged and roomy. The hull is carefully hand-laminated of the finest glass cloth. The cockpit is sealed so water can't penetrate the length of the boat. There's an ample splash coaming to keep you dry, and all oarlocks, tracks and fittings are the same quality you find on professional racing shells. To top it off, a pure white hull and blue accent make the shell look as fast as it travels. In the words of one rowing editor, "this is the shell for a long canal trip. It will do anything a rowboat will do, but about eight times as fast."



Who says all rowboats should have only one pointed end? Maine and Adirondack guides will tell you differently. They know that there's no swifter, quieter, easier way to steal upon fish or duck than the classic double-ended lake rowboat—a mainstay of Old Town catalogs since the turn of the century.

We make two models. One is the famous Old Town Double Ender, built by hand in our wood shop from native cedar ribs, western red cedar planking, mahogany and Sitka spruce. This 16-foot all-wood masterpiece comes with mahogany backrests as a standard feature. Double oarlocks let two people row.

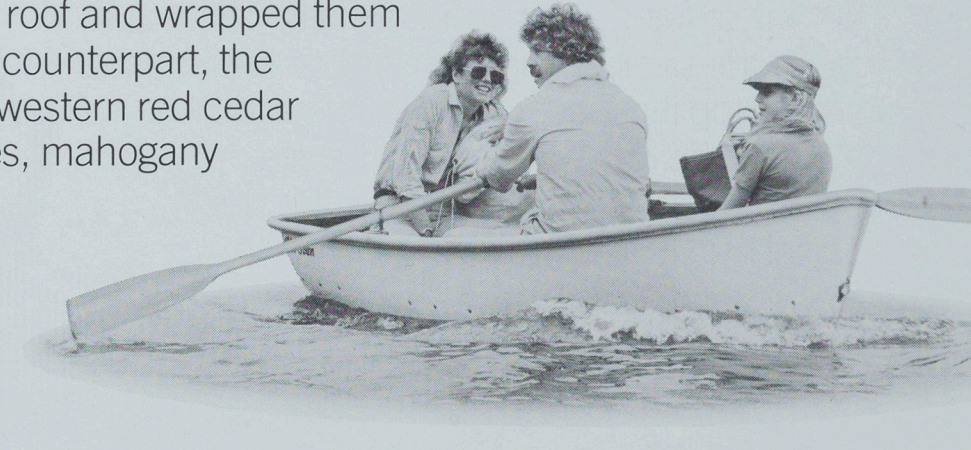
The second model is the Rangeley, identical in design to the Double Ender, but built of Oltonar Royalex®, the remarkably tough and pliant laminate we developed for our whitewater canoes. Like the Double Ender, the Rangeley has cedar seats and mahogany and Sitka spruce gunwales.

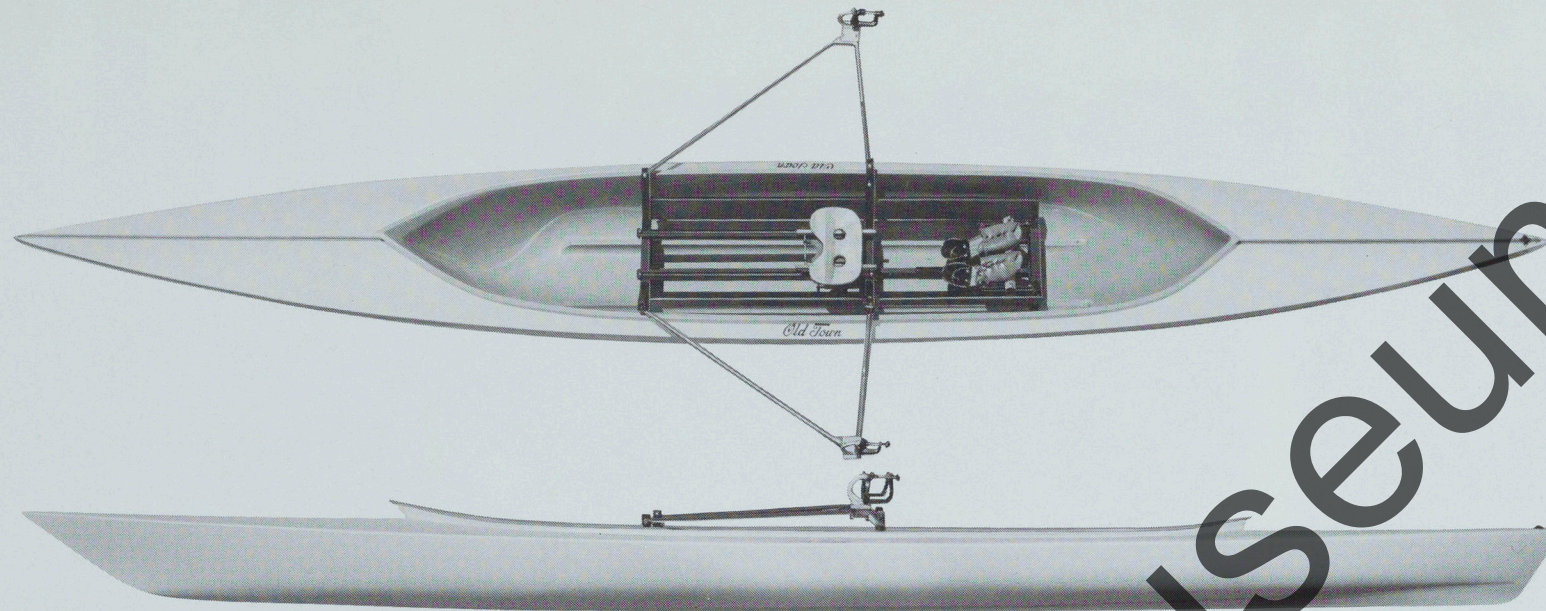


People think of Old Town as a company with a century's experience building fine craft for America's top canoeists. The fact is, we've spent just as many decades building fine craft for America's yachtsmen.

The Old Town dinghy is a study in classic simplicity and functional beauty. Working by hand on turn-of-the-century forms, our woodsmiths build the dinghy to order with native cedar ribs, western red cedar planking, mahogany decks, seats, transoms and gunwales. Fittings are bronze. And a carefully hand-laminated white fiberglass surface protects the wooden hull.

A second classic dinghy is available this year in Oltonar Royalex. Which may make it the toughest tender in the world. Virtually maintenance free, our Oltonar Royalex hulls are so strong and resilient we've dropped them off the factory roof and wrapped them around bridge abutments. Like its all-wood counterpart, the Oltonar Royalex dinghy has bronze fittings, western red cedar seats, mahogany and Sitka spruce gunwales, mahogany transom and deck.





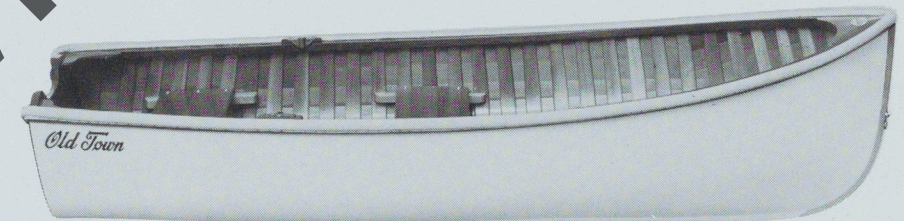

Canoe equipment and cedar strip kit.

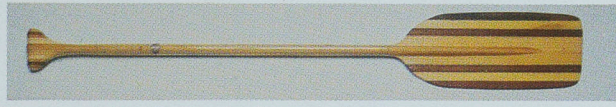
Paddles.



Clement 2408. Made for us by famous Clement of Canada. Hardwood-tipped laminated spruce blade measures 24" x 8". Handle is hickory or ash reinforced. Lengths: 58", 60", 62".



Sawyer SCT-9. Noted canoeist Ralph Sawyer makes this whitewater paddle for Old Town. Wood has unmatched strength and flex. Fiberglass reinforced blade, T-grip handle. Lengths: 58", 60", 62".



Sawyer SCT-8. Exclusive design for Old Town. Oval grip, rugged, fiberglass-reinforced. Lengths: 58", 60", 62".



Old Town classic beavertail paddle. Single blade spruce. Lengths: 4'6", 5', 5'6".

Kayak Paddles.

Pressure-molded white fiberglass blades on yellow fiberglass shafts. We supply paddles with one blade attached. Second blade is unattached so you can precisely set length and control. Glue included.



Flat blade double paddle. Maximum length, 215 centimeters.

Flat blade double paddle. For the Optima Sport. With drip rings. Length, 96".

Spoon blade double paddle. Maximum length, 215 centimeters.

Sail Rigs.



Specify canoe model and serial number.

Mast seat and step.

Aluminum tilt rudder.

Leeboards with crossarm, complete.

Lateen sail. Blue and white stripe or red and white stripe. Sizes: 55 sq. ft. and 75 sq. ft.

Spray Protection.

Canoe rain cover. Covers entire canoe with built-in spray skirts over seats. Keeps canoe and cargo dry. Rugged, reinforced Facilon plastic fabric. Folds easily. Snap fasteners. Specify canoe model and length. Green cover, white skirts. Not recommended as a whitewater splash cover.



Spray skirt. Hypalon with rubber shock cord drawstrings. Specify kayak model when ordering. White.

Neoprene spray skirt. 1/8" unicellular neoprene nylon-lined. Small (to 30" waist). Medium (30"-34" waist). Large (over 34" waist).



Old Town Canoe Kit.

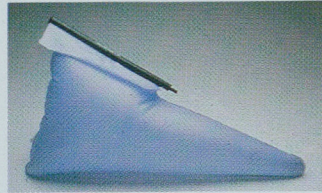


Complete kit of materials and instructions for assembly of a 17 ft. cedar strip canoe. Western red cedar strips, Sitka spruce inwales, mahogany outwales. Decks, thwarts, seats, glass cloth are all included. Basic tools, frame and form (cut from our pattern) are all you need.

Waterproof Cargo Bags.



Day bag. Top grade 20 mil vinyl with electrically sealed seams. Velcro closure. 18" x 24".



Kayak float pack. 60" x 28" (stern). 40" x 24" (bow).



Heavy duty plastic bag. Waterproof and insect-proof storage plus flotation. Duplex bag in three sizes. Camp pack, 22" x 36". Expedition pack, 24" x 60". Kayak pack, 17" x 40".

Water Repellent Carrying Bags.

Duluth-type canoe backpack.

Canoe stuff-sack. Orange water repellent fabric with drawstring, shoulder strap and carrying handle.

Life vest (PFD). Custom designed for Old Town, with our logo, by Omega. Highly visible yellow with a distinctive green stripe. Extra comfort and good looks. USCG approved. Sizes: S, M, L, XL.



Gore-Tex® paddling jacket. Made for Old Town exclusively by Holubar Mountaineering. Velcro sleeves, collar and kangaroo pouch. Drawstring neck and waist. Color: rust. S, M, L, XL.

Old Town T-shirt or tank top. 50% polyester, 50% cotton. Assorted colors. S, M, L, XL.



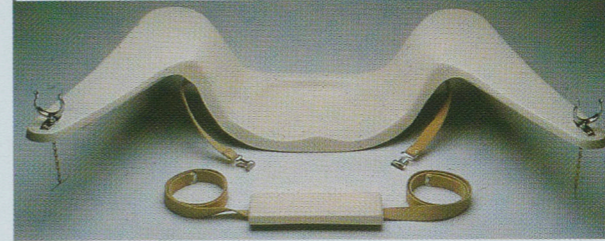
Wind shirt. Bulkless polyurethane-coated nylon. Elasticized neck, waist, wrists. Men's and women's. S, M, L, XL.

Joffa helmet. Lightweight high impact plastic helmet will float. Ventilated, washable, replaceable snap-on chin strap. One size fits all.



Rowing.



Fixed rowing seat. Comfort-contoured. Oarlocks out-board. Adjustable straps secure footbrace. Spoon blade fiberglass oars (7 ft.) are available. Rowing seat color: Desert White.

Hull Flotation.



Flotation bags. Necessary protection for all covered craft. Vinyl bags with middle baffle, double valves. Specify kayak model when ordering.

Center bag. For Optima Sport, Berrigan.



Cartop Carriers.



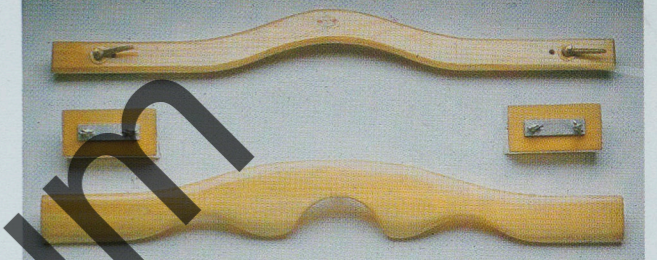
Quick 'n Easy carriers. 60" for single canoe, 72" for two canoes.

Utility carriers for gutterless car roofs. 60" for single canoe, 72" for two canoes.

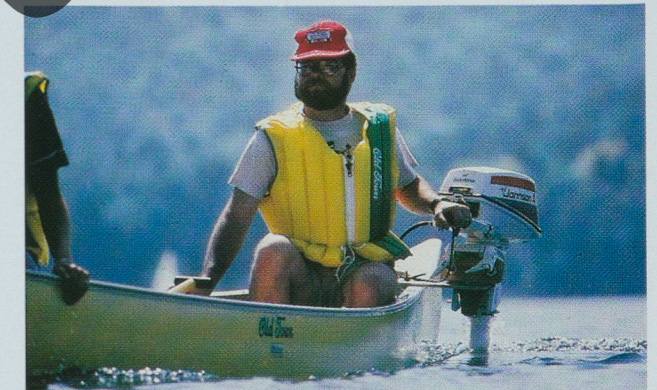
Foam block canoe carrier. Block and rope for complete carrier kit.
