This scrapbook belonged to William Lieber, part owner of the "Davy Jones". Due to its deteriorated condition the contents have been transferred to this black three ring notebook. The beginning pages (1-46) were found randomly placed in the front of the scrapbook in no apparent order. They were placed in the new notebook in the order they were found. Sleeves are consecutively numbered.
