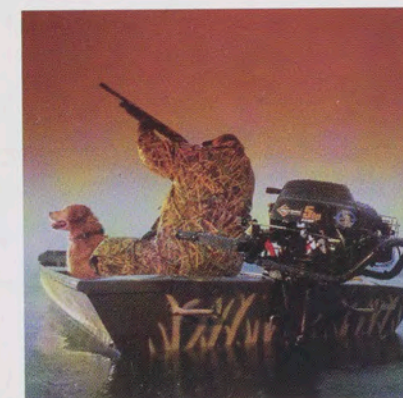
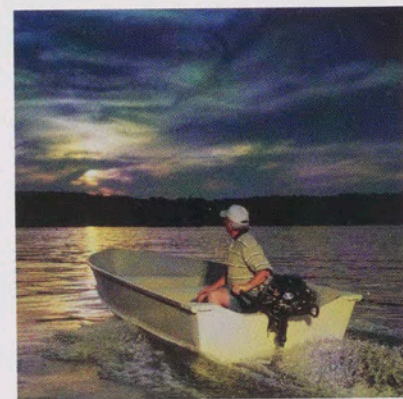

The Outboard is recommended for boats with a transom height of 15". To promote proper fit and safe operation, please refer to your boat's NMMA certification plate.

8. Can I use my Outboard in salt and brackish water?

The Briggs & Stratton 5hp Outboard is designed for freshwater use. Salt and brackish water are extremely corrosive and can lead to premature failure of components. Such failures are not covered under the Briggs & Stratton limited warranty.

9. Does the Outboard meet all environmental regulations?

Yes. The efficient Briggs & Stratton 5hp 4-cycle OHV Outboard meets the EPA's 2006 emissions standards as well as CARB's emission standards.

10. Is the Outboard portable?
