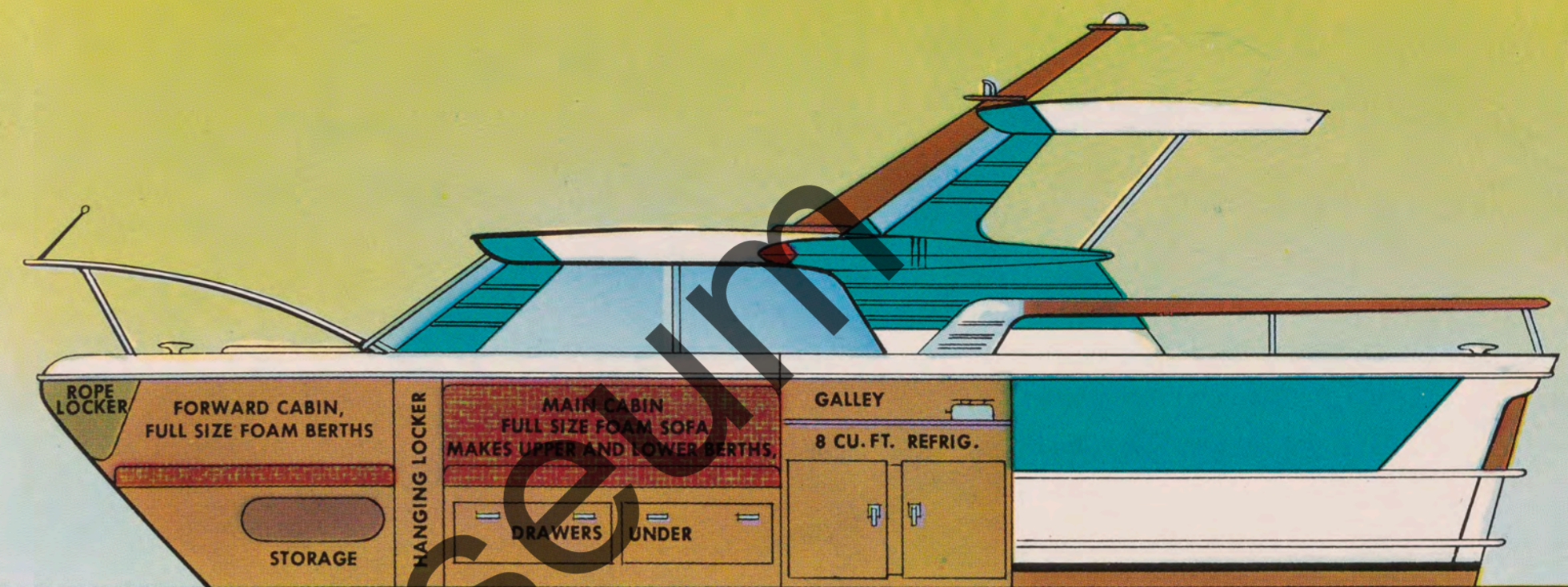

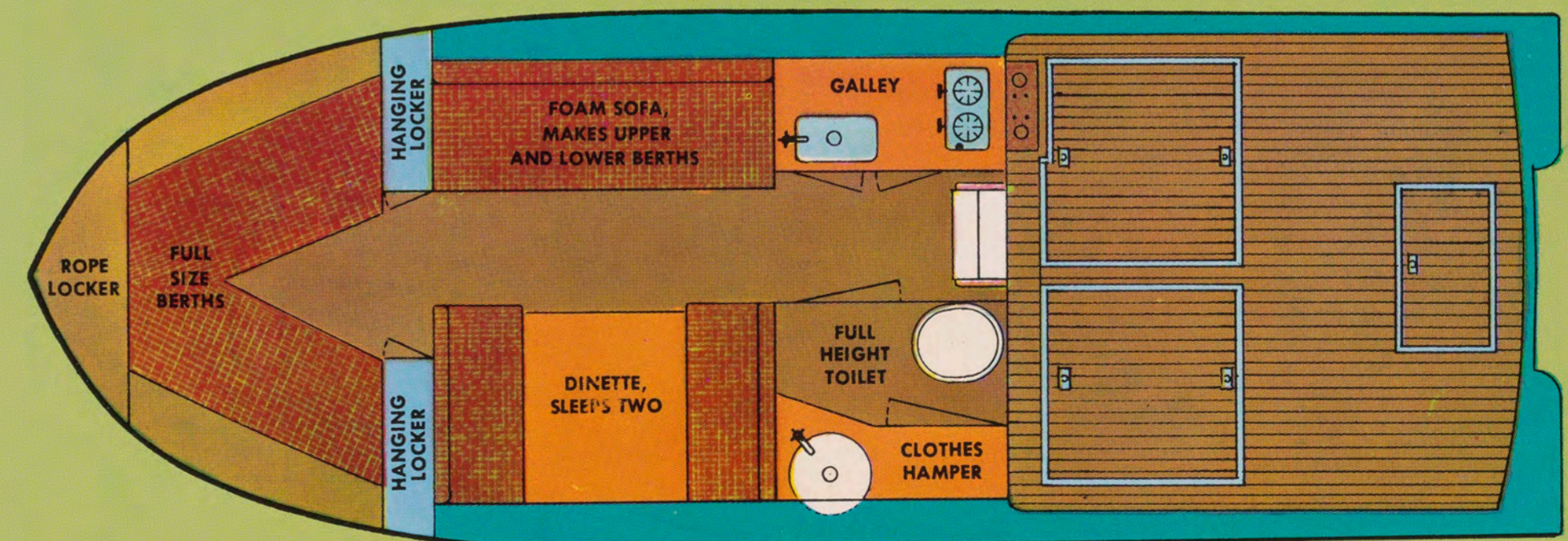


Cabin Interior; Starboard Side Shown

2. Full sized dinette which converts into comfortable double bed.
3. Opposite dinette in main cabin is featured six-foot lounge sofa convertible to upper and lower six-foot berths.
4. Forward, conventional six-foot berths; all upholstery polyether foam, beautifully upholstered in naugahyde.
5. Full sized galley, eight cubic feet double door ice refrigerator. Two burner, pressure type alcohol stove that conveniently folds away into a locker when not in use, giving unusual work-top space for preparing meals, etc.
6. Stainless steel large galley sink is equipped with pressure water system requiring no pumping.
7. Opposite the galley is a full height toilet room with pressure water in lavatory, large mirror, dressing table, built in clothes hamper, and marine head.
