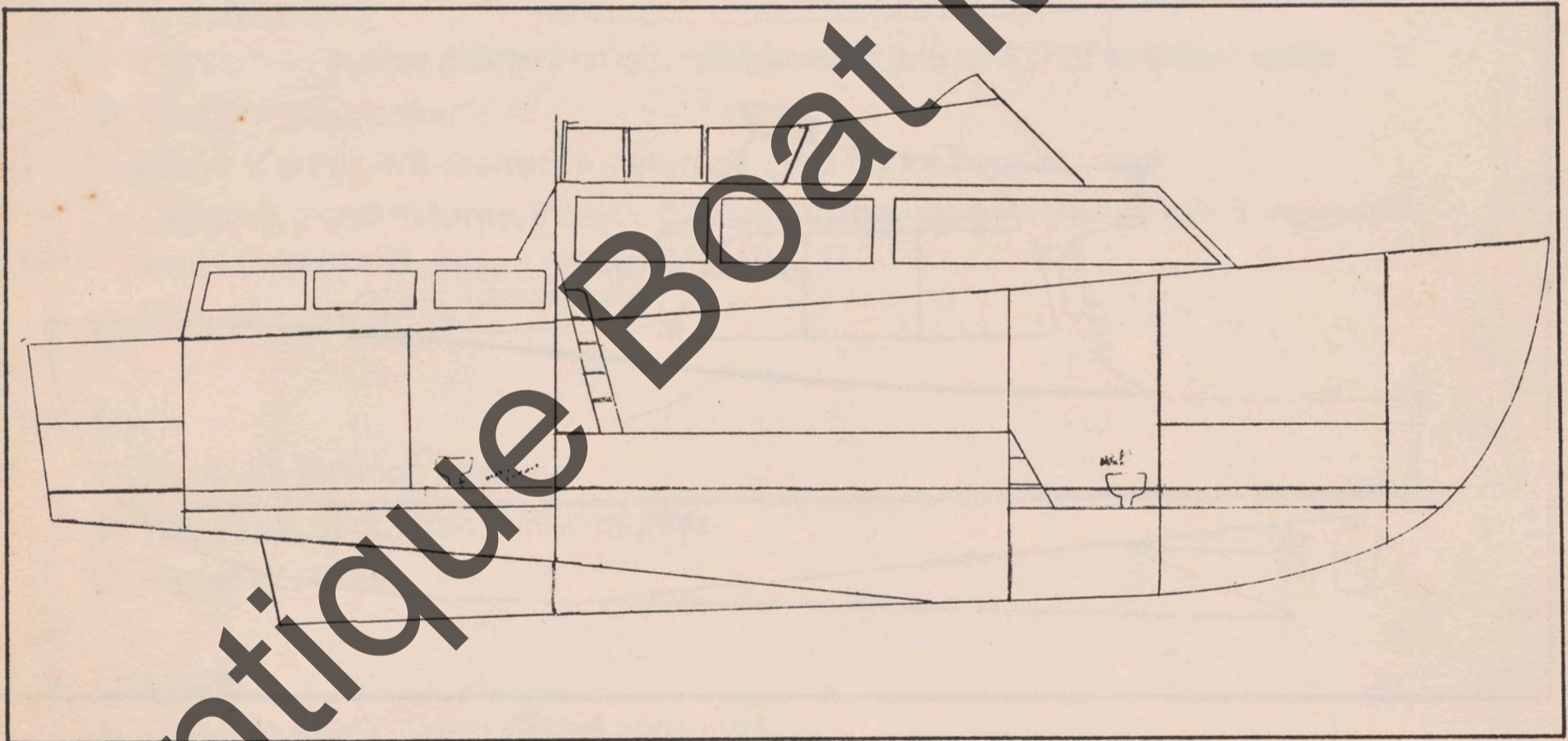

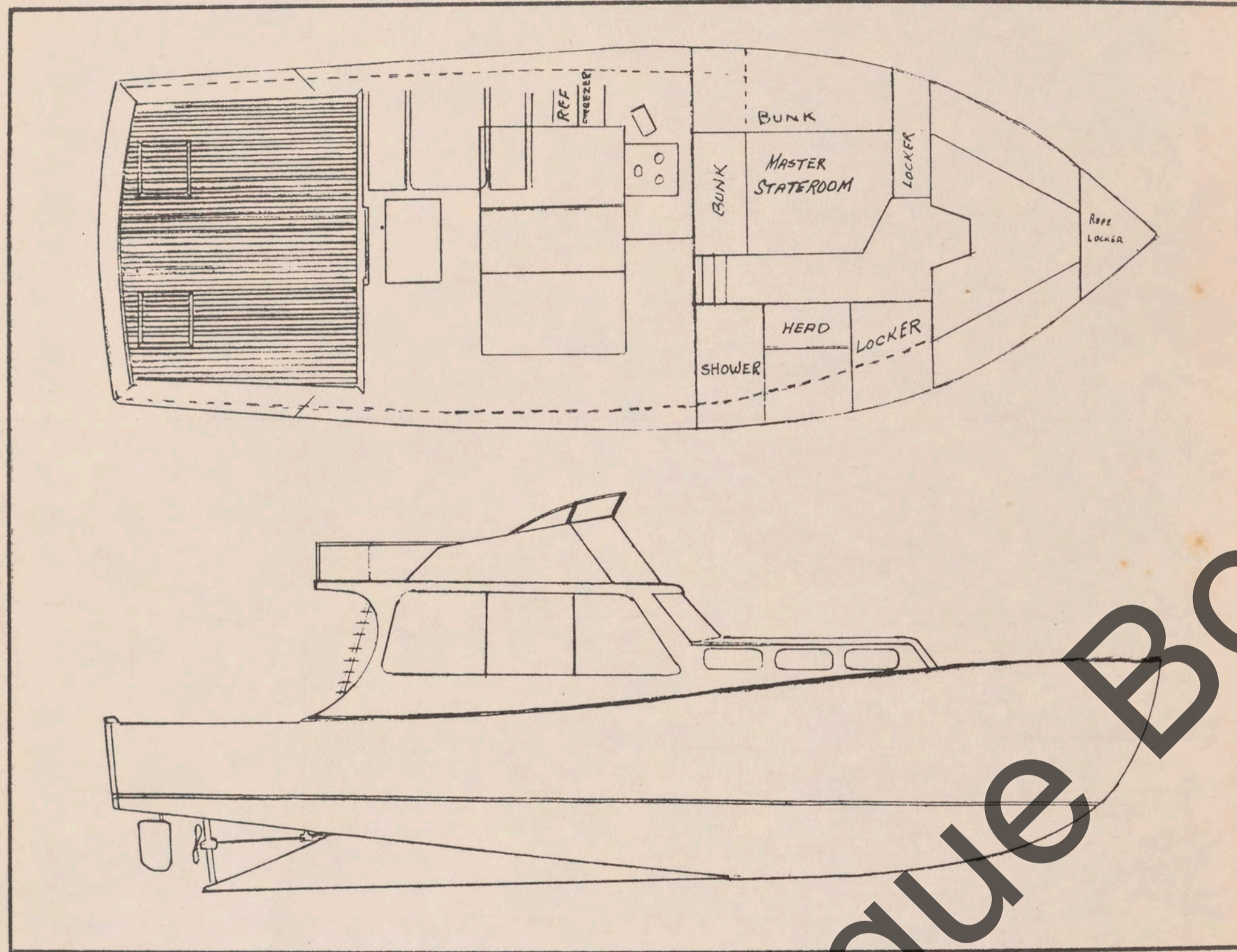

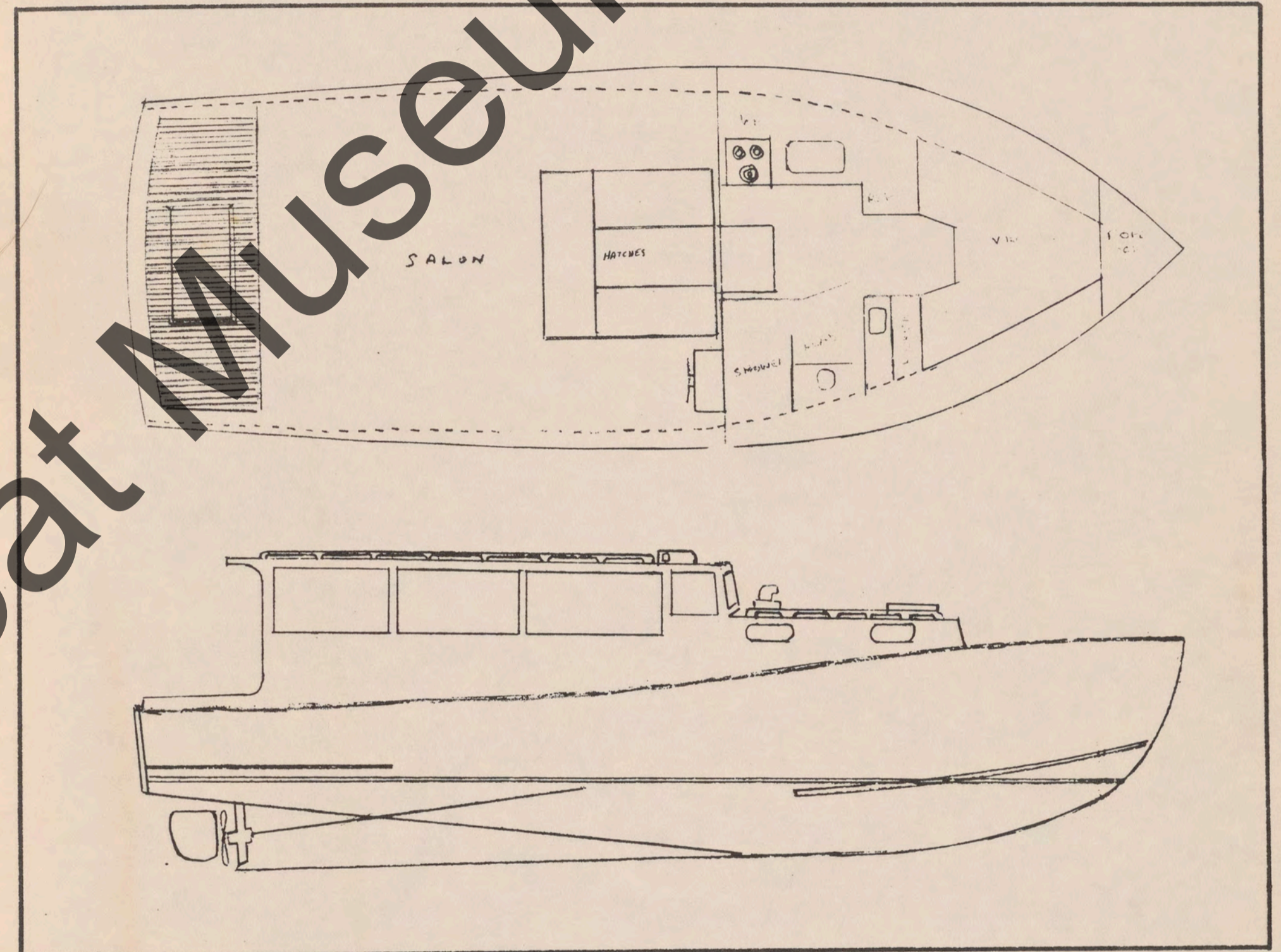

ADAMS 36 SPECIFICATIONS

I. Hull

- A. Adams 36 epoxy glass over wood construction hard chine V bottom planing hull
- B. Hull colors and boot top colors optional

II. Super Structure

- A. Main decks epoxy glass over marine plywood
- B. Cabin, salon, windshield combings, hand rails, mahogany varnished, guard rails painted
- C. Interior of salon mahogany varnished with exposed laminated deck carlins, deck carpeted, color optional
- D. Cabin varnished trim w/white bulkheads
- E. Head w/sink and cabinet, shower formica bulkheads, epoxy glass shower pan, par hand operated head
- F. Galley w/3 burner electric range, refrigeration and sink, hot and cold water
- G. One hanging locker
- H. Large V berth w/6 drawers for storage, plus under bunk storage
 - I. Lighting, 2 wall fixtures, V berth, 2 overhead fixtures galley area, 1 fluorescent fixture over sink in head, 1 overhead fixture in shower
- K. Shower sump drain

III. Mech

- A. Hynautic steering system
- B. Wet exhaust out transom w/muffler
- C. Morse controls

IV. Electrical

- A. Running lights, Coast Guard approved
- B. Basic wiring with 2-30 amp 110V shore connections
- C. Automatic bilge pump
- D. 1 8D H.D. Batt
- E. Circuit breaker paner

V. Deck Hardware

- A. Brass half oval on all rubrails and quarter rails
- B. Bow bit optional either S.S. or hardwood
- C. Four bronze portlights
- D. Bronze spring cleats and stern cleats, bronze chocks forward, bronze hawse's transom, two hawse pipes for rope locker
- E. Cabin top hatch main cabin

VI. Tankage

- A. One 235 gallon fuel tank under salon deck
- B. Two 40 gallon water tanks under salon deck
