

Heroic Phila. Pilot Killed in Florida

A Philadelphia naval pilot recently awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for heroism in the Pacific was killed Sunday when his plane collided with another during a training flight at Deland, Fla., it was announced last night.

He was Lieutenant John B. Barcalow, son of Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin Barcalow, of the Hotel Normandie, 36th and Chestnut sts. The pilot of the other plane parachuted to safety. Lieutenant Barcalow returned to the United States several months ago.
