OBITUARY

DIED--In this town, on Wednesday morning, the 6th inst., Capt. JAMES QUIGLEY, aged 50. The bereavement experienced by this afflictive dispensation of an all wise providence, cannot fail of being most sensibly felt and lamented by the inhabitants of this village generally, and the numerous acquaintances of the deceased. For 13 years past he had been a resident in this place, and during that time had occupied an important sphere in the community of which he was a member. That he filled that sphere creditably to himself, and usefully to his fellow men, there are many to testify--many who have long known him as an agreeable companion, a faithful friend, a kind neighbor, a worthy citizen, and an exemplary Christian. How great is the loss sustained by his family by his removal, can be fully appreciated only by her who is bereft of a fond husband, and the children who mourn for an affectionate father. Let it, however, be recorded with gratitude to God, that the testimony furnished by the life of the deceased, of the sincerity of his Christian profession, warrants the most consoling hopes of his participation beyond the grave, in that "rest which remains for the people of God."
