

- 1864 Church lived at 104th & Wadsworth. Built stage station there in 1864. Upper & Lower Church Lake were first storage reservoirs in Colo.
- 1870 76th & Lowell homesteaded
- 1880 no Rail Road yet.
- 1881 Rail Road goes through Blunners' property.
- 1882 Dry Creek School built at 112th & Pierce. Later called Lorraine School
- 1884 post office on 120th. 5 mile west of Sheridan

1885 Yang owned 400 acres of what is now Broomfield. Main entrance was on 10th & barns at about 6th & Poppy. Waids' "Elmwood Ranch" lay about 4 miles east of Broomfield. Yang owned 2000 acres at airport & Great Western Reservoir, plus 2000 acres from near original highway north along Rt 287 to across from Sac Amora east as far as Main St. Willow Lake on the northeast sold in 1947, then sold to Turnpike Land Comp.

- 1887 Broomfield established
- 1888 Earliest grave in Lakewood Cemetery. (2 acres)
- 1894 Post Office moved west
- 1898 Broom. gets grange hall
- 1900 Broom. get mail delivery
- 1901 post office in Jones Bldg., also had grocery store.
- 1905 Crooks bought 80 acres north of telephone office

1896 Olson homesteaded 80 acres bounded by Pierce & 120th.
Broom. shopping center was farms
early 1900's the telephone bldg. was east side of Lowell Blvd.
1907 Methodist Church built on Allison St.
