'75: 5/8 acre lot, house is combination barn and cottage house, Victorian style, residential use, gabled roof, metal over wood shingles, clapboard with brick lining, rainwater cistern in basement. Initial construction in 1835, back portion added on at turn of the century and modernized by present owner (Harry Bird). Built in colonial style but modernized toward Victorian four on four originally. Once a three-family, then two family, and now one family. Owned by Peter Stall 1866, Alexander Bassett 1869 (sold land to Conklin), Henry A. Conklin 1866, Mrs. Hallock around 1940. Present owner and occupant in 1975 Harry L. Bird. Older photo in '75.
