THE BUDD FAMILY

Sons of William Budd, descendants of my grandfather, Eugene E. Budd Sr, crossed from Normandy to invade England with William the Conqueror and fought with him at the Battle of Hastings in 1066. Some remained on English soil and gave the name of Rye to the village on England's southeast coast, near Hastings, where they settled. William the Conqueror become King of England and one the Budd brothers John, married his sister and was made Earl of Sussex. John Budd and his descendants built up Rye and married into the families of the Brownes, Nevils and the Montagues. During the war of the Roses, many Budds fell with their cousins, Earl and Lord Montague. The Nevils, Budds and Brownes lost royal favor with the succession of Edward VI to the throne of England and this was a factor in the migration of the brothers John and Joseph Budd to America in 1632. John Budd, direct ancestor of the Dutchess County Budds, came with his wife, the former Katherine Brown to New Haven, Connecticut in 1639. From there they went to Southold, Long Island and later to the shores of Long Island Sound in Westchester County, New York, which they name Rye.
