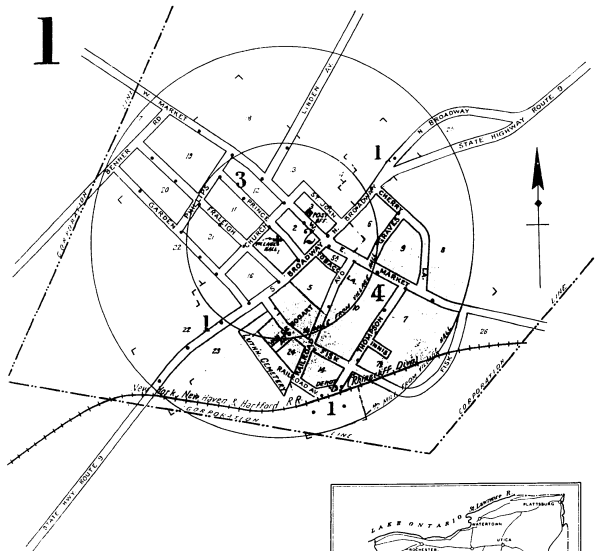

WATER FACILITIES

Served by Village. Source from 2 dug wells. Gravity pressure system. 1 reservoir, capacity 400,000 gallons, elevated 200' above corner at Broadway and Market St., located 2 1/2 miles East of Post Office. Reservoir filled by 1 Gould triple electric pump, capacity 75 gallons per minute. 1 Myers gasoline pump, capacity 75 gallons per minute, in reserve. Reserve supply from creek at pumping station.

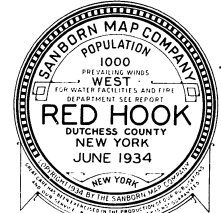
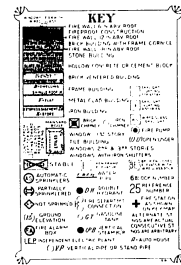
About 3 miles of 4" to 8" mains. 45 public hydrants. Average daily consumption unknown. Pressure at corner of Market St. and Broadway 90 lbs.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Volunteers: 1 chief and 40 men. 1 station. 1 Buffalo triple combination truck with 500 gallons per minute pump, one 150 gallon booster tank, 150' booster hose and 1,000' 2 1/2" hose. American-LaFrance combination truck with two 35 gallon chemical tanks and 500' 2 1/2" hose.

Steering fire alarm system with headquarters located in Village Hall, a two-story frame building. Alarm by electric siren on Village Hall, operated from telephone office.
