The Mill Road Elementary School Addition is designed for education in grades K - 3 and includes the following facilities:

- * 26 classrooms for grades 1 - 3
- * 10 classrooms for Kindergarten Education
- * Library and A. V. Center
- * Two station gymnasium complete with shower facilities
- * Cafetorium and serving kitchen
- * Administrative and health facilities and a room for speech therapy
- * A curriculum center for faculty use
