A Word About These Records

The record which follows is a faithful copy of the original and is as free from error as circumstances allow. Cases of illegibility or uncertainty are copied with brackets (____) to show that the letters or dates enclosed by those brackets are questionable. Apparent errors in spelling or dates were copied as found and interpretation is left to the reader.

The third volume of vital records of St. John's Lutheran Church, Manorton has not been located. It embraces a period of time from 1872 through the 1930's. Therefore, the marriage record for this church ends with 1872 in this transcript.

The Index

In idexing, an attempt was made to merge surnames only if the divergent spelling was clearly the same name when pronounced, or if sufficient evidence was present to indicate that two widely different spellings must be the same name. The surname will be found listed under the most modern spelling or the spelling that occurred most frequently in the record.
