HELMET WITH EAR FLAPS

Materials:

2 ozs. 4-ply fingering Navy or Royal Air Force Blue.  
4 No. 6 double pointed needles.

Recipe:

Cast on 96 stitches.

Knit 2 purl 2 for 5 inches.  
Proceed as follows:

Knit 2 purl 2 for 24 stitches and place these on a piece of wool for the face. Work 2 ridges or 4 rows of plain knitting on the remaining 72 stitches.

5th row:

Knit 10 stitches, put the remaining 62 stitches on a spare needle and knit 12 ridges or 24 rows, on these 10 stitches and put these 10 stitches on a piece of wool.

Then knit 52 stitches and on remaining last 10, knit the same as before, 12 ridges or 24 rows and put on a piece of wool. Then, knit your remaining middle 52 stitches for 12 ridges or 24 rows.

Pick up all 72 stitches and knit 14 ridges or 28 rows.

Knit 47 stitches, slip 1, and knit 1, pass slip stitch over and turn. Next row, knit 23, slip 1, and knit 1, slip stitch over and turn. Repeat this row until all stitches are worked on the needle. (24 stitches)

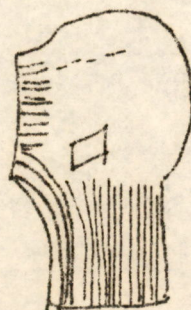
Knit 24 stitches and pick up 28 stitches for right side of face and put back 24 chin stitches on needle and knit 2, purl 2, for chin. Then pick up 28 stitches for left side of face.

There should be 104 stitches in all and knit 2, purl 2 on these 104 stitches for 12 rows and cast off in usual way.

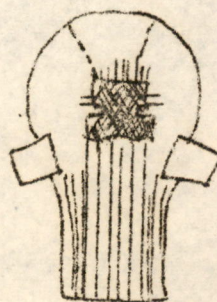
Ear Flaps:

With helmet facing you, on the nearest side of the right ear slit, pick up 18 stitches and knit in stockinette stitch, for 26 rows and cast off.

Knit the other ear hole slit in the same manner.

HELMET WITH EAR FLAPS

2 ozs. 4-ply fingering Navy or Royal Air Force Blue.  
4 No. 8 double pointed needles.

Materials:

Cast on 96 stitches.

Reshape:

Knit 2 puri 2 for 5 inches.  
Proceed as follows:

Knit 2 puri 2 for 24 stitches and place these on a piece of  
wool for the face. Work 2 ridges or 4 rows of plain knit-  
ting on the remaining 72 stitches.

5th row:

Knit 10 stitches, put the remaining 62 stitches on a spare  
needle and knit 12 ridges or 24 rows, on these 10 stitches  
and put these 10 stitches on a piece of wool.

Then knit 52 stitches and on remaining last 10, knit the  
same as before, 12 ridges or 24 rows and put on a piece of wool.  
Then, knit your remaining middle 52 stitches for 12 ridges or  
24 rows.

Pick up all 72 stitches and knit 14 ridges or 28 rows.

Knit 47 stitches, slip 1, and knit 1, pass slip stitch  
over and turn. Next row, knit 23, slip 1, and knit 1,  
slip stitch over and turn. Repeat this row until all  
stitches are worked on the needle. (24 stitches)

Knit 24 stitches and pick up 28 stitches for right side  
of face and put back 24 chin stitches on needle and knit  
2, puri 2, for chin. Then pick up 28 stitches for left  
side of face.

There should be 104 stitches in all and knit 2, puri 2 on  
these 104 stitches for 12 rows and cast off in usual way.

With helmet facing you, on the nearest side of the right  
ear slit, pick up 18 stitches and knit in stockinette  
stitch, for 26 rows and cast off.

Ear Flaps:

Knit the other ear hole slit in the same manner.
