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INTRODUCTION

DUTCHESS COUNTY, NEW YORK PROBATE RECORDS, 1787 - 1865 (including Wills, Letters Testamentary, and Letters of Administration)

This book is a listing of those persons who had Wills probated in Dutchess County, NY and of those who are associated with Letters Testamentary and Letters of Administration on file at the Surrogate's Office, Poughkeepsie, NY.

WILLS

The first section, pages 1 through 60, is a calendar referencing abstracts of 2081 Wills that have previously been published. The publication of these abstracts occurred in two quarterlies, namely, The RECORD (abbreviated REC in the fifth column on pages 1-8) produced by the New York Genealogical and Biographical Society, and The DUTCHESS (abbreviated DUT in the fifth column on pages 8-60) produced by the Dutchess County Genealogical Society. Dutchess County Wills in The RECORD occurred in 1930 in issues #1-3 and covered the periods of time from 1787 to 1795. The DUTCHESS then extended this information in volumes 4 through 20, and covered the period 1795 through 1839.

Additional information about each Will or its abstract can be found in this volume by consulting the fourth and/or fifth column of pages 1-60. The fourth column provides the book letter and page number of the original Will; the fifth column is the name and issue of the quarterly where the abstract will be found.

Since a system of county surrogate's courts was not established in New York until 1787, estate records for earlier years were handled in the then state capital of New York City. Therefore, some Wills prior to 1787 for Dutchess County may be found in either of two published volumes,- Fernow's *Calendar of Wills on File and Recorded in the Offices of the Clerk of the Court of Appeals, of the County Clerk at Albany, and of the Secretary of State, 1626-1836*, or the New York Historical Society's *Abstracts of Wills on File in the Surrogate's Office, City of New York, 1665-1800* in their 15-volume collection published from 1892 through 1906.

It is expected that the editor of The DUTCHESS will continue publication of the names in the Will Master Index for those Wills probated 1837 through 1905 and is beginning such publication in the spring 1997 issue of that journal. They will be presented alphabetically.

LETTERS TESTAMENTARY AND OF ADMINISTRATION

The second portion of this book is the presentation of Dutchess County Letters Testamentary and Letters of Administration on pages 61-232 describing 5360 loose sheets that have been bound together in book form. These books were microfilmed by the LDS Church and the originals and the microfilm were used in the production of this book. Each Letter was given a sequential number and pertinent genealogical information was recorded for each entry. The order in which the Letters appear in this book is the same order in which they appear in their original Liber. Other than the microfilm, the compiler is not aware of these Letters having been published before.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If further information about a person mentioned in this book is desired, be aware that there may be additional papers relating to the Will or Letter by inspecting numbered folders associated with them at the County Courthouse. To determine whether or not such folders exist, you must consult the Will Index books at the Dutchess County Courthouse, Market Street, Poughkeepsie, NY. Much useful genealogical information is often available and is waiting to be discovered.

THE INDEX

The index, on blue pages, prepared for this volume is a literal index, i.e. you must search every known spelling for a given surname, such as Smith, Schmidt, Smythe, etc. The number in the index is followed by a "W" or by an "L". "W" for Will and "L" for Letters are the sequential numbers used in each section to identify the item. Every person mentioned in each section will be found in the index.

Remember, - indexes and abstracts serve as guides only and should be verified in the original record book or file. Handwriting in the original documents is difficult to decipher and consequently the abstracts are known to include many inaccuracies. Verification of information which is not from the primary source is always desirable but in the case of the probate records, this is especially true. It must be recognized that it is not possible or practical to provide all of the information which the documents contain. However, this book should serve to identify instruments of interest so that a valuable probate record will not be overlooked,
