Physical papers relating to the Upper Red Hook Society including member lists, treasurers' reports, dues records, newsclippings and photographs.

Biographical/Historical Note

The Upper Red Hook Society is believed to be the oldest continuously operating Horse Thieves Society in the country. It meets annually to this day, gathering members for a dinner and talk on a horse-related topic.

Provenance

The Lower Red Hook ledger was found in a box of papers belonging to past Society treasurers that was unveiled at the 2017 Annual Dinner. The Upper Red Hook Society's papers were in the same box. The Upper Red Hook ledgers were scanned by NYS Library in 2011.
